PORTLAND MEN BID LOWEST.—Bids for making alterations in the Postoffice were opened Friday by Postmaster Minto. The lowest tender was found to be that of Langford & Walker, of this city. The plans and specifications furnished by the Treasury Department yesterday called for an estimated expenditure of \$5000 and provided for utilizing all the space possible in enlarging the working departments of the office. One change is to give the postmaster's reception room into the stamp-selling section and the present assistant postmaster's room into the newspaper and parcel distributing room. The assistant postmaster will have his office in part of the space now occupied by the postmaster. Other changes will take up considerable vacant space on the ground floor, where all the contemplated alterations in the building are to be made. Mr. Minto forwarded to the Treasury Department yesterday the bid of Langford & Walker for approval and acceptance by the department, upon which the work will be undertaken at once.

NEW BANK OPENS SEPTEMBER 1.—Portland's new National bank, the National Bank of Commerce, will open its doors for business September 1, according to President W. H. Moore, of the Oregon Trust & Savings Company, who will also be president of the new institution. The bank will have a paid-up capital of \$250,000 and will occupy the same building as the Oregon Trust & Savings Bank at the corner of Sixth and Washington, until the growth of the institution demands larger quarters. A safety deposit vault is being put in the corner room on the ground floor of the new bank of the Oregon Trust as soon as the building is completed.

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WILL MAKE MANY IMPROVEMENTS.—At the meeting of the Seaside Improvement Club, at the home of Judge A. L. Frazer at 970 Ellsworth street, Friday night, a special committee was appointed to wait on the Executive Board to expedite street improvements under way and others yet to be started. Through the work of the club 14 streets are to be improved. Resolutions for most of these streets have been adopted by the Council. The improvement of Clinton street from East Twelfth to East Fortieth is the most important. It will be of hard surface pavement most of the distance. Gas mains and double tracks are to be put down before the improvement begins. The club has been assured that the neighborhood will be provided with fire apparatus for a volunteer company yet to be formed. Fire hydrants, water mains and electric lights also have been promised the club. President Joy reported that the special committee from the Board of Education would visit that section the coming week on the location for a schoolhouse. The club is an aggressive, active organization, and has already started many improvements in that district.

District No. 12 Annexed.—The annexation of school district No. 12 to Lents to Portland district No. 1 has been accomplished in conformity with the vote of last month. M. M. Eaton, clerk of Lents district, last Wednesday turned over to the clerk of the Portland district the property and cash on hand, thus closing the transaction. Mrs. Eaton turned over a little more than \$1000. Out of \$9000 of bonds there are no debts. There will be 30 students from this district to enter the Portland High School the coming Fall. Last year the schoolhouse was overcrowded, and more room will have to be provided. In the district there are more than 600 pupils of school age. Probably two rooms will be provided at about Woodmere next year.

DEATH OF MRS. MCCORMICK.—A dispatch received yesterday from Los Angeles brings news of the death in that city of Mrs. Helen M. McCormick, who was for many years a resident of the East Side. Mrs. McCormick accompanied her son, H. S. McCormick, to Los Angeles three years ago. Though deeply attached to Portland and to her friends of a third of a lifetime, she went willingly where duty called her. She was a woman of kind, unselfish nature and left behind her the record of an upright life reaching nearly four-score years. She died July 5 at the age of 78 years 8 months and 5 days. Her son, H. S. McCormick, survives her. Her husband died many years ago in this city.

SPICES DOWN SUNDAY LEO.—That the Sunday law is being spiced down and clenched was made certain yesterday morning by the decision of Judge Cameron in the Sam Waffler case. Last Sunday Sam Waffler, who is the proprietor of the Uncle Sam Hotel, served drinks to some friends in the living room over the saloon. In his decision the court placed upon the fact that there was evidence of guilt because of the attempt to hide the liquor when the officers entered. The decision is important, for a contrary decision would have practical effect on the effect of the Sunday closing law. The defendant was fined \$15. The case will be carried to the Circuit Court.
