BROADEN SCHOOLS' SCOPE
Mothers' Congress Advocates Using
Buildings to Extend Influence.

WASHINGTON, March 14.—At a meet-
ing of the advisory council and officers
of the National Congress of Mothers held
at the White House today, at which Pres-
ident Roosevelt presided, a letter was
read from Commissioner of Education
Brown, endorsing the movement for which
the congress has stood from the begin-
ning, looking to the use of public school
buildings for meeting purposes to accom-
plish an extension of the influence of
the schools in the community and at the
same time to bring about a more fruitful
participation of the parents in the social
life of their children. The Commissioner
said:

"This seems to me one of the ways in
which the schoolhouses can be made a
more valuable asset for the community."
The suggestion received the hearty ap-
proval of the President and council.
