

PASSENGER RATES WILL NOT BE CUT

North Pacific Steamship Company Will Maintain Prices to San Francisco.

EUREKA BUSINESS HEAVY

Bulk of Traffic Handled by the Roanoke and George W. Elder Is Between Eureka and San Francisco and Portland.

The North Pacific Steamship Company, owners of the steamships Roanoke, Geo. W. Elder and F. A. Kilburn, will not make any reduction in passenger rates between Portland and San Francisco.

"Why should the North Pacific Company meet a cut on San Francisco passenger business?" said Mr. Young yesterday.

"I think that the action of the San Francisco and Portland Steamship Company is directed at the steam schooners which operate direct between San Francisco and Portland.

STEAMER NEMANTIA CLEARS

Regular Oriental Liner Carries a Big Cargo of Flour for Siberia.

The steamer Numania, of the Portland & Astoria Steamship Company, cleared yesterday for Hongkong, via Siberian ports, with a general cargo of 25,000 barrels of flour.

The Numania will carry on her present outward voyage 35,000 barrels of flour for Vladivostok, East Siberia, and 10,000 barrels for Nuchwang, North China.

CHARTERED AT 25 SHILLINGS

Balfour, Guthrie & Co. Will Load the British Ship Arctic Stream.

Balfour, Guthrie & Co. will begin loading the British ship Arctic Stream tomorrow morning. She will take a cargo of flour and other goods for the Arctic.

The Arctic Stream arrived in port February 19 from Kottorad in general cargo. She had been chartered out by the British Government.

VALOROUS IN THE MUTINY

DEEDS OF BRITISH HEROES ARE RECALLED.

One Buried With Military Honors and the Other Awarded a Pension by King Edward.

LONDON, March 14.—The terrible Indian mutiny of 1857 has been recalled to the minds of people here recently by facts concerning two brothers who performed acts of heroism in those trying times.

One, E. J. Churcher, has just been awarded a pension of \$500 per annum in recognition of his services.

Another, David Churcher, has just been buried with military honors at Patehgarh, the place he helped to defend 50 years ago.

E. J. Churcher is indebted to the direct intervention of the King, through His Majesty's private secretary, Lord Knollys, for this recognition of a romantic deed.

David Churcher, now 76 years old, is a tall, commanding figure. His tread is still elastic, his manner dignified, and his speech quiet but full of force.

LIKE A BUNCH OF TRACK BULLETS

"Bill" Haywood Is Bringing Out Some Splendid Material at Oregon.

STRONG IN THE SPRINTS

Moore and Huston Will Make Up for Kelly's Loss—Distance Men Make Splendid Showing—Many Candidates for the Team.

UNIVERSITY OF OREGON, Eugene, Or., March 14.—(Special.)—The recent fair weather has brought out a large number of candidates for the varsity track team, and the oval on Kincaid Field has been crowded each evening with ambitious sprinters and hammer-throwers.

Trainer Haywood has adopted a system of preliminary training for all track and field men, which includes relay races each evening. Relay teams are made up of all the men out for practice and each man is required to run from 50 to 100 yards at the best speed.

The Oregon team will be remarkably strong in the distances this year, which feature will to a degree make up the loss of Kelly in the sprints and jumps.

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NEW MATERIAL IN POLE-VAULT.

Oregon's strength in the pole vault cannot be sized up closely. Moulten, the regular varsity vaulter for the past two years, and Captain-elect next year's football team, will retire from participation in this event on account of overweight.

The most promising man in the vault is "Dusty" Jones, who ran and jumped at McKinley College for the past two years. Another good man for the vault is Robinson, who learned the rudiments of track work at Portland High School.

The hurdles will be looked out for by Captain Kuykendall, Moore and Huston. The first two men run the high hurdles and the latter two the low hurdles.

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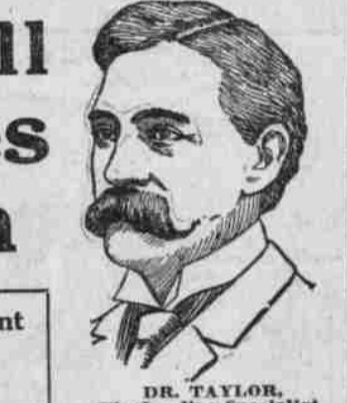
