State Will Turn Over Plant on Clackamas.

TO BE IN FEDERAL CHARGE

Master Fish Warden McAllister Reports That Canneries Hereafter Will Provide Food for Salmon Fry, Saving State Money.

On July 1 the Clackamas River, including the Cazadero hatchery station, will be turned over by the state authorities to the United States Commissioner of Fisheries and these properties will be in charge of Henry O'Mally, Government superintendent of fisheries for this state. This disposition of the Clackamas River hatchery business was decided upon at a recent meeting of the Board of Fish Commissioners of this state. The Board was assured that it would lose nothing by the transfer, inasmuch as the Government has agreed to turn over to the state any eggs it might require. The question of feeding young fry at the different hatcheries operated by the state during the coming season was considered. Master Fish Warden McAllister reported that he had talked with all of the canneries on the Columbia River and they had promised to pack the heads, melt and row of the salmon, in gallon cans, without any expense to the state, other than the cost of the cans, the same to be distributed to the different hatcheries. This product, it was explained, can be used as fish food at much less expense than liver, which has been used in the past. Reports were read from R. D. Hume and F. A. Seufert showing that the natural fish food, being the heads and offal of salmon, was far superior to liver and the other foods that have been used in this state. Mr. McAllister was directed to establish a hatchery at Bonneville, if he found conditions satisfactory, and the appointment of J. W. Berrian as superintendent of this proposed hatchery was approved as follows: E. C. Greenman, A. J. Sprague, J. W. Talbert and Bliss Thorn.

Mr. McAllister also reported that he had found it almost impossible to visit the different hatcheries as often as he deemed it advisable. He said he had found at such hatcheries as he visited that the ex-Master Fish Warden had not visited them for the last three or four years, due to the fact that the duties of the office required the greater part of his time. Mr. McAllister's suggestion that an inspector of hatcheries be appointed to visit these stations at least twice a year was endorsed. The Board appointed Charles Babcock, of Oregon City, to fill that position at a salary of \$5 a month. The receipts of the Master Fish Warden's office for the month of May were as follows: District No. 1, fines and penalties, \$66.67; licenses issued, \$108.3; total, \$174.97. District No. 2, licenses issued, \$25.50; total receipts for the month, \$149.47. Accounts against the department aggregating \$858.90 were approved.

USED POISON TO MURDER

DOCTOR TELLS HOW MRS. GUNNESS KILLED HELGELEIN.

Arsenic and Strychnine in Stomach. Effort to Prove Woman Alive and Capture Her.

LA PORTE, Ind., June 20.—The first positive information on the murder in which Mrs. Bella Gunness, the arch-murderess, disposed of the persons whose bodies were found in her private cemetery was obtained today, when Dr. Walter Haynes, of Rush Medical College, Chicago, reported informally to Coroner Mack that he had found traces of arsenic and strychnine in the stomach of Andrew Helgelein, of Aberdeen, S. D., whose 48-membered body was the first of the ten found after the fire, which caused the death of Mrs. Gunness and her three children.

H. W. Worden, attorney for Ray Lamphere, indicated for the murder of Mrs. Gunness, her three children and Andrew Helgelein, today in a formal statement scored the county authorities for their action and also made a public appeal for subscriptions for a fund to be used as a reward for the apprehension of Mrs. Gunness. After referring to the fact that the Coroner has officially pronounced Mrs. Gunness dead, Mr. Worden declared that Ray Lamphere's guilt or innocence does not depend upon whether Mrs. Gunness is dead or alive, but from certain evidence that has come into his possession, he concluded the woman is enjoying life and liberty.

FATAL END OF BUGGY-RIDE

Man Mortally Wounded, Woman Dead, Horse Astray.

NEW PHILADELPHIA, O., June 20.—How Howard Spach, 45 years old, was probably fatally wounded and Miss Arline Kniesly, 24 years of age, was killed last night is a mystery which the police are trying to solve. Fallen over the side of a buggy, the horse walking slowly about in the heart of the city, the body of Miss Kniesly, a bullet in her brain, was found by two men who halted the animal.

A few yards distant Spach was found, a bullet-hole above his right eye. "I've been shot," was his muttered remark. Since then he has been unconscious. The police found a revolver in the buggy, four chambers of which contained discharged shells. Spach is married. For some time he had been operating a theater, in which Miss Kniesly was a ticket-seller.

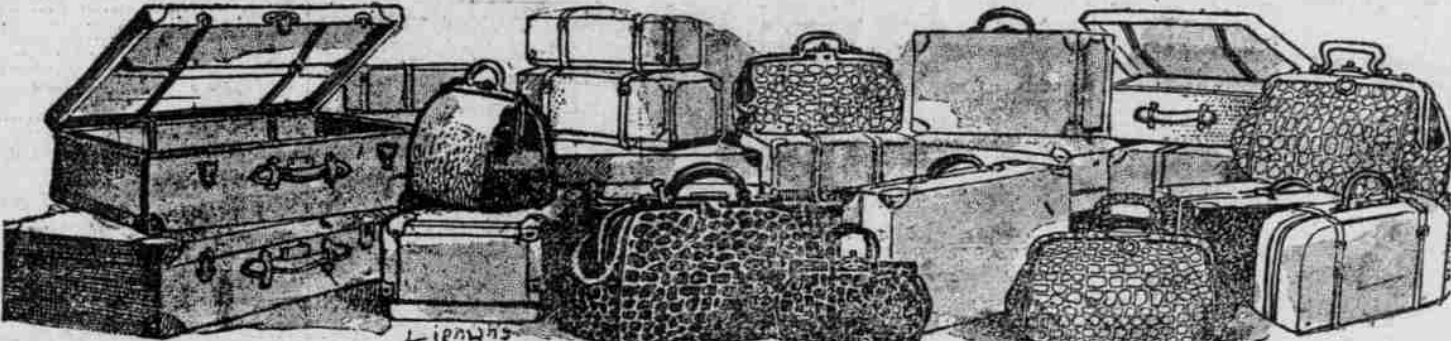

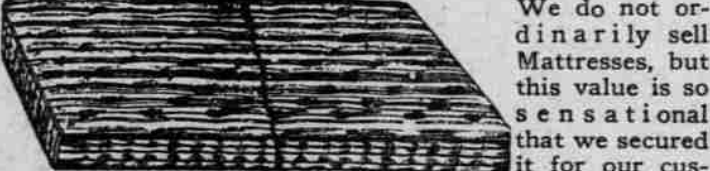
