

JUBILANT OVER REPUBLICAN HUE

Chicago Registration Startling in Showing Great Democratic Losses.

OUTLOOK MOST BRILLIANT

Secretaries Garfield and Wilson Give Strong Reasons for Their Predictions of Taft's Election. May Get Oklahoma.

CHICAGO, Oct. 3.—(Special).—Republican National headquarters were related tonight at the close of Chicago's first registration day. The figures all have a rosy Republican hue. In past elections the enrollment has been a trustworthy prospectus of what was to be the product of the subsequent election and the Republican managers are confident that this year will not prove an exception to the rule.

Examples of Gain and Losses. Some of the conspicuous examples of this may be shown as follows: Republican wards—gain: Sixth ward 1222, Seventh ward 1281, Twenty-fifth ward 1281, Twenty-sixth ward 1274, Twenty-seventh ward 1252, Thirty-fifth ward 1252. Democratic wards—loss: First ward 573, Ninth ward 1749, Tenth ward 1774, Twelfth ward 1774, Seventeenth ward 2085, Eighteenth ward 1774, Nineteenth ward 1774.

The total registration for the day was 366,217 in the Chicago wards, as against a registration of 252,675 for the first day's registration of 1904, and of 267,364 for the first day of 1906. The comparison naturally should be made with the figures of 1904, that being the last Presidential registration.

All Lovely in Ohio.

Two members of President Roosevelt's Cabinet called at National headquarters during the day and brought with them reports of the progress of the campaign in different parts of the country. They were James R. Garfield, Secretary of the Interior, and James Wilson, Secretary of Agriculture.

"Republicans are awakening all over the country," said Mr. Garfield. "We are having our usual crop of scares, but the Republicans are getting their fighting clothes on and are intent on upholding the full party strength in November. That is all they will have to do to win."

"All talk about Republican trouble in Ohio is moonshine," said Secretary Garfield. "The Republicans are wide awake there and there is no sign of factional discord. There is nothing in the situation here that presents any unusually disquieting feature whatever. Likewise in Indiana the Republican party is in excellent shape."

Secretary Wilson said that the American farmers pretty generally remember the conditions that prevailed from 1892 to 1897, and want no repetition of them.

Farmers Strongly for Taft.

"The farmer is overwhelmingly for Taft and Republican policies," he said. "Appreciating as he does the difference between the prices of his products now and from '92 to '97, does any person suppose that the American farmer is going to count commercial suicide?"

W. E. Andrews, auditor of the United States Treasury, stopped at headquarters long enough to say that New York Democrats rely upon the West to elect Bryan.

Frank H. Lathrop, manager of the Republican campaign in Alabama said: "Few business men in Alabama want to see Bryan elected. Just as soon as the people become convinced that Taft will be elected, they will rush to get into the band wagon. North Alabama and Middle and East Tennessee now are Republican." The Republican managers are exceedingly hopeful about the chances of Oklahoma going Republican. W. J. Drummond, editor of the Oklahoma Daily Eagle, of Enid, who called at headquarters during the day, said:

"Stranger things could happen than that the new state will cast its Presidential vote for Taft and Republicanism."

TOWN WILL INCORPORATE

Willamette Accepts Proposition by Vote of 36 to 3.

OREGON CITY, Or., Oct. 3.—(Special).—The citizens of Willamette passed the act which makes them an incorporated town by a vote of 36 to 3. The matter was brought up before the people by an initiative petition. The direct cause of this was the desire of the people of that section of the county to own the water system which the Portland General Electric Company, the present owners, wished to get rid of.

Willamette is a thriving little place on the west side of the Willamette River and connected with Oregon City by an interurban carline. Aside from those employed in the shoe factory at that place, Willamette is made up of people who work or are in business in Oregon City.

PAYS \$3 TO \$4 FOR SHEEP

Tacoma Packing-House Buys 8000 Head for Mutton.

TACOMA, Wash., Oct. 3.—(Special).—Thomas Carsten, president of the Carstens Packing Company, has just returned from Eastern Washington and Oregon, where he purchased 8000 head of sheep, paying from \$3 to \$4 each. Notwithstanding the fact that the mutton market is a little off, partially on account of the enormous number of sheep in Australia, President Carsten said that as a whole the farmer has not been receiving such high prices for livestock in years.

The filing of papers with the clerk of the Federal Court at Moscow would appear to be the first gun of one of the biggest legal battles ever entered into in Idaho.

The Federal Company will not ask for an injunction restraining the Bunker Hill & Sullivan Company from taking ore out of the disputed ground, but will simply demand an accounting for ore already extracted.

The Federal Company claims to have the apex of ore bodies, the extent of which it estimates, and it is probable that that the decision will involve millions of dollars.

STANDARD TO BE HIGHER

SENTENCE ON HANCOCK FORE-TASTE OF REQUIREMENTS.

General Grant Says Standard of Army Should Conform to Ordinary Positions of Trust.

NEW YORK, Oct. 3.—(Special).—Captain Gwynn B. Hancock, of the Coast Artillery Corps, has been found guilty of a serious offense in the line of rank for using intoxicants to excess, which caused his admission to the post hospital at Fort Hamilton after he had declined treatment. In personal orders announcing the finding, Major-General Grant says: "Under modern conditions there does not exist in the United States a large corporation engaged in industry, manufacturing or transportation that would retain in its employ a man with personal habits of intemperance such as was proven the accused has had. The standard of efficiency in the Army, instead of being lower, should be higher than that of the best of the most perfectly organized corporation, and the evil effects upon discipline of the example of chronic alcoholism in one selected for command is too great to be tolerated."

JOHN STOTT BEHIND BARS

Milton Man Is Accused of Supplying Liquor to Minors.

PENDELTON, Or., Oct. 3.—(Special).—John Stott, a local keeper of the Scotch Cap light house, was lodged in the County Jail today, while M. V. Townsend, of Freewater, charged with selling liquor contrary to the prohibition law, and who has been in jail for several days in default of \$1000 bail, secured bondsman today and was released from custody.

LIGHTKEEPER IS SUICIDE

Puts Bullet Into Breast After Buying Drink in Astoria Saloon.

ASTORIA, Or., Oct. 3.—(Special).—Fred Larson, a light keeper of the Scotch Cap light house at Unalaska, shot himself through the breast about 2 o'clock this afternoon and inflicted injuries which are expected to result fatally. Cause of the rash act is unknown.

Larson arrived here a few days ago on the light house tender Armeria, and has been around town ever since, but has not been drinking heavily. This afternoon he walked into the Anchor saloon on Astor street, stepped up to the bar, bought a drink and asked two or three other men to drink with him. After paying his bill, he walked into a rear room, sat down in a chair, and taking a revolver from his pocket, shot himself.

DIES FROM KNIFE WOUND

Dalles Bartender Succumbs to Thrust Made by Sheepherder.

THE DALLES, Or., Oct. 3.—(Special).—Andrew A. Wilcox, a bartender of the Bar saloon in this city, who was stabbed by Joe Shoughnessy, a Condon sheepherder, on Thursday night in that resort, died today from his injuries.

A preliminary hearing was given Shoughnessy, at which he was bound over to await the action of the grand jury on a charge of murder in the first degree. Wilcox was a single man, about 32 years old. He had no relatives in this community.

Robert A. Smith, Sporting Writer.

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 3.—Robert Ashton Smyth, one of the best-known sporting writers in the country, died here today of cancer of the stomach. Mr. Smyth was a native of County Cork, Ireland, the son of a noted Irish sportsman. He went to Australia while a lad, coming to San Francisco nearly 20 years ago and making a name for himself as a bicycle racer. From this he turned to newspaper work, joining the sporting staff of the San Francisco Examiner 15 years ago. Five years later he became sporting editor of the San Francisco Call, which position he filled until he retired last July on account of ill health. He was 43 years of age and leaves a mother and sister, both in this city.
