The vessel will probably get away from Astoria today or tomorrow. She was originally on the list for Puget Sound.

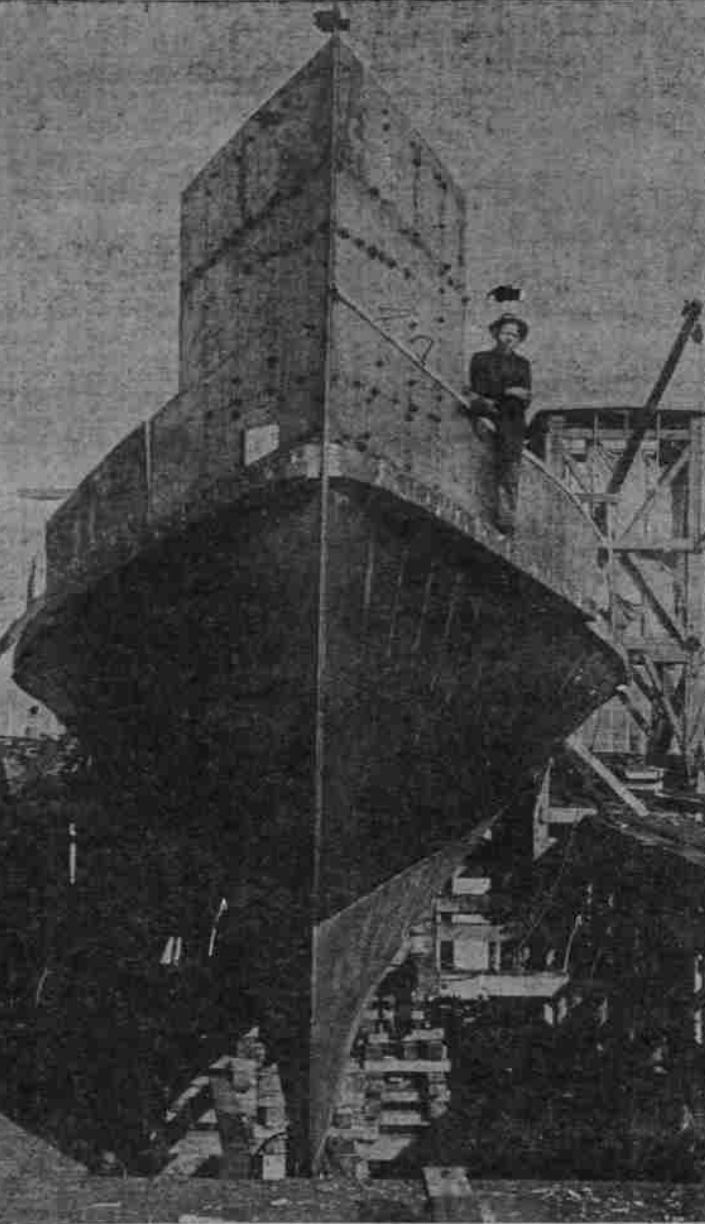
Steamship Angot Fixed for Lumber.
