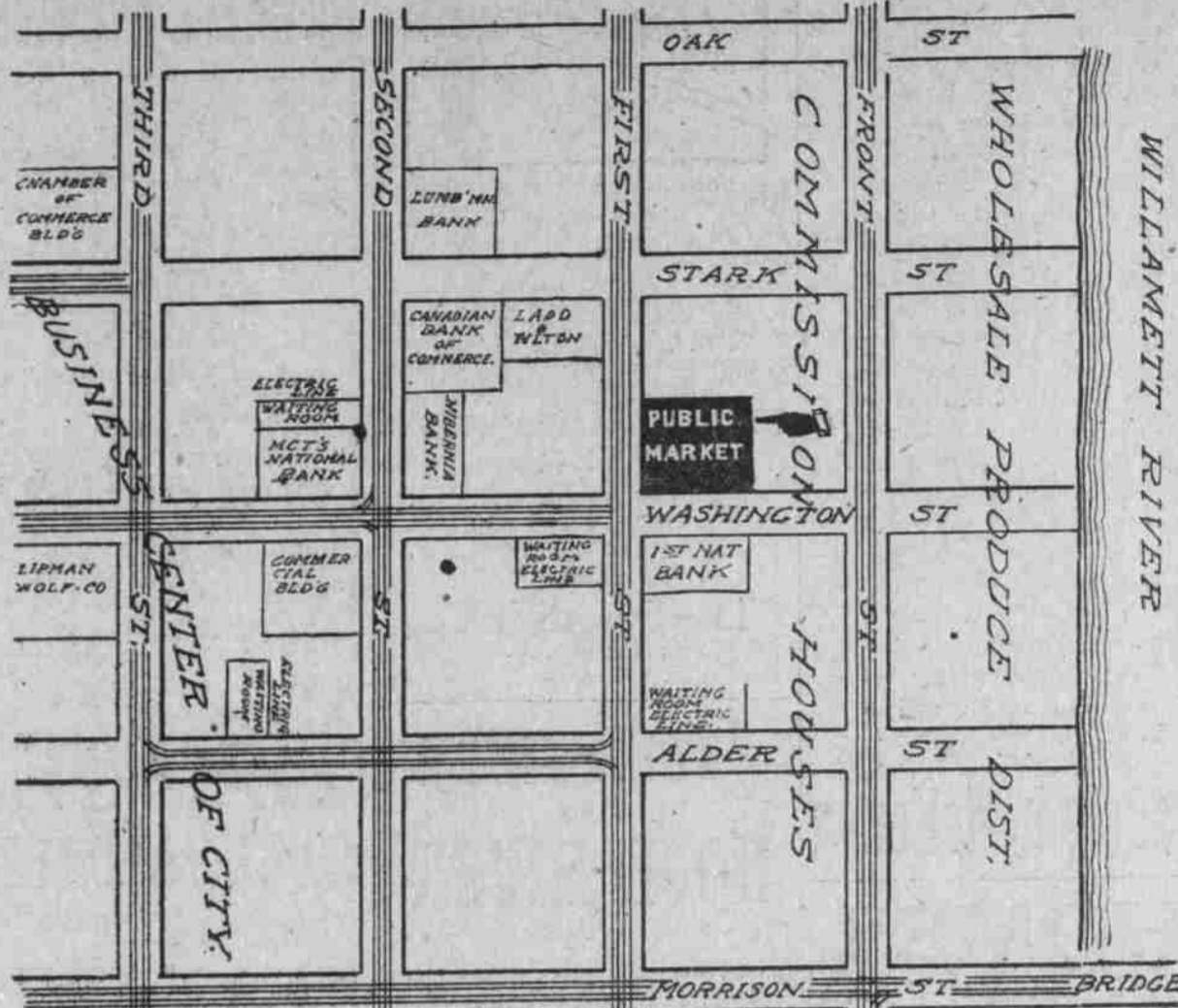

PARTIES BATTLE FOR LEGISLATURE

Indiana Senatorship Is Prize Over Which Contest Is Being Waged.

SITUATION SAME AS 1887

Democrats Control House and Republicans Have Majority in Senate—Former Deny Election of Every G. O. P. State Officer.

INDIANAPOLIS, Dec. 19.—(Special.)—Men who are conversant with Indiana political history are watching the various steps in the legislative situation with a great deal of wonder and wondering if history is going to repeat itself at the coming session. As compared with the memorable struggle ending with the election of David Turpie over Benjamin Harrison to the Senate in 1887, the situation is precisely the same, except that the positions of the two parties are exactly reversed, the Democrats then being in control of the Senate and the Republicans having a majority in the House of Representatives.

Carrying out the analogy, the Republicans had fled a number of contests with the evident intention of unseating Democrats in the House, and thus getting a majority on joint ballot. Now the Democrats are contesting the election of the Republican state officers with one exception.

The Senate majority is preparing to meet the Democrats on exactly the same ground that the Democrats met the Republicans in 1887, or in other words, are arranging to contest the election of one Democrat in that body for every contest that the Democrats consider in the House. They say their action will be the same as the Democrats' action regardless of the merits of the individual cases.

HUBBARD VOTES ROAD TAX
Property-owners Propose to Expend \$1200 in Improvements.

HUBBARD, Or., Dec. 19.—(Special.)—The voters of road district No. 2 met yesterday and voted a 3-mill tax for road improvements. It is estimated that a 2-mill tax will be the means of raising about \$1200, and this sum is to be expended in graveling a part of the Pudding River road leading into the town from the east.

County Judge William Bushy attended the meeting and in a short address explained the operation of the present tax law and gave an estimated cost of the county's business for the coming year.

Breaks Windows While Drunk.
OREGON CITY, Or., Dec. 19.—(Special.)—Otto Fout, an Austrian, who has been employed in the Catholic Home at Oswego, is in the County Jail charged with breaking two windows at the institution. He had been drinking and cherished a grudge against the place. Fout will have a hearing in the Justice Court. He was committed by Justice of the Peace Kelso, of Milwaukie.

EARLY PAY FOR CHRISTMAS
Willamette Paper Company Pleases Its Employees.

OREGON CITY, Or., Dec. 19.—(Special.)—The Willamette Pulp & Paper Company, with a pay roll of more than \$500,000 per annum and about 500 employees, has made a new departure that is appreciated by the men. It is the custom of the company to pay wages on the 9th and 13th of each month, but in next Monday night, December 21, the company will give the employees their Christmas spending money for Christmas. The management announced this morning that all of the men would be paid next Monday night, December 21, shutting down at 6 P. M. Thursday and resuming operations at 7 o'clock Saturday morning.

SENATORS' LIVES IN PERIL
Annex Building Where Quartered Is Declared Unsafe.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 19.—The fact that a large number of Senators have been occupying quarters for the past several years that were perilous to life in the Senate Annex building, that is now encased should have been condemned, was emphasized today by the refusal of Elliott Woods, superintendent of the Capitol, to permit any increase of the weight upon the floors through the admission of documents needed by the National Monetary Commission.

The building is situated one square from the Capitol buildings. The finance committee of the Senate, three Democratic Senators and a half dozen Republican Senators have their office rooms in the building, but within the next few months they will move to the handsome marble structure which is just being completed for use as Senate offices.

BEATS CHAMPION CYCLIST
Taylor Wins Match Sprint Race With Floyd McFarland.

BOSTON, Mass., Dec. 19.—Floyd McFarland, of San Jose, Cal., winner with James Moran as partner, of the recent six-day race in New York, was defeated by Major Taylor of Worcester, tonight in a match sprint race. Taylor won two out of three heats, the first, a one-mile sprint race, in 2 minutes, 43 seconds, and the third heat, a one-half mile sprint, in 1 minute, 7 seconds. McFarland won the second heat, which was a one-mile pursuit race, in 1 minute, 57 2-5 seconds.

NEW REGISTER AT YAKIMA
President Appoints Saint Because He Is Accountant.

OREGONIAN NEWS BUREAU, Washington, Dec. 19.—The President today nominated Harry B. Saint of Grandview, Yakima, the office having been vacant through the death of the late incumbent, Mr. Saint was recommended by Senators Pillsbury and Ankeny. Previously they recommended Franklin Laubert, of North Yakima, but Secretary Garfield would not assent to his appointment, because he is not an expert accountant. This qualification is now required of all appointees to registrations.
