**KAMM PLACE IS LEASED**

**EASTERN MEN SECURE PROPERTY AND EXTENSION.**

Two Sides of Glass to Be Put Up. Market of New Kind to Be Installed on Site.

A lease was signed on the Kamm property, northeast corner of First and Washington streets, yesterday, for ten years with a five-year extension clause. Eastern investors acquired the lease through the negotiations of Will H. Walker, acting for the firm of Hartman & Thompson.

A three-story building will be erected on the property and work will begin as soon as arrangements can be made with the contractors. It will be of brick and cement and the two sides on Washington and First streets will be of glass. The entire ground floor of the building will be devoted to a public market of a class as yet unknown in Portland. The remainder will be devoted to business offices. Details of the structure have not yet been worked out, but these matters will be arranged within the next few weeks. Actual construction will be started soon after the first of the year.

D. K. Robb, Mayor-elect of Granite Falls, Wash., who is president of the Broadacre Farm Products Company, with headquarters at Everett, Wash., figures prominently in the transaction, for his company will have a large part of the space on the ground floor of the building. The realty firm of Hartman & Thompson will attend to the leasing of the remainder of the ground floor.

"We propose to establish as fine a public retail market in Portland as there is anywhere," said Mr. Robb yesterday. "Two sides of the ground floor of the building will be enclosed with glass, making it attractive. The huckstering feature, that is prominent in many markets, will be entirely eliminated. There will be two entrances on Washington street and four on First street. As the location is handy to the various streetcar lines of the city, the market will be convenient to residents of the various sections of Portland.

The Kamm property has laid idle for years and the leasing and the erection of a building will improve its appearance to a great extent. The ground is 100x100 in size. Its location is especially suited to a public market and the assurance is given that the establishment will be of a character that will be a credit to any city of the country.

The terms of the lease and the names of the Eastern people who acquire the use of the Kamm property for ten years are withheld for the present. The Broadacre Farm Products Company has its headquarters at Everett, Wash.
