

NO MORE CABINET OFFICERS CHOSEN

Taft Says Many Have Been Suggested, but Only Knox Decided Upon.

WILL ASK KNOX'S ADVICE

His Brother's Paper Says Herrick is Choice for Treasury and Pinchot and Garfield Stand but Little Chance.

AUGUSTA, Ga., Dec. 19.—As an answer to the numerous newspaper cabinet suggestions made recently in many quarters, President-elect Taft said tonight that he had made no progress whatever in making up his cabinet aside from the Knox appointment.

CINCINNATI, Dec. 19.—A special from Augusta, Ga., to the Times-Star, (the paper owned and edited by Charles F. Taft, a brother of the President-elect) says:

When Philander C. Knox, the Taft Secretary of State, comes to Augusta to discuss with the President-elect the making up of the remainder of the new Administration's Cabinet Mr. Taft will ask him to approve of Myron T. Herrick, ex-Governor of Ohio, as Secretary of the Treasury. This fact can be stated as coming from authentic sources.

When Mr. Knox arrives at Augusta, within the next week or so, Mr. Taft will submit to him for his inspection and approval the list of names he has selected.

SCRAMBLE FOR KNOX'S JOB

Pennsylvania Republicans Would Succeed to Senatorship.

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 19.—Early indications point to a scramble among well-known Republicans to succeed United States Senator Knox, who has accepted the offer of President-elect Taft to become Secretary of State.

The Republican caucus will be held on January 4. Senator Knox's term expires March 1911, and his successor will be elected to serve out the unexpired term.

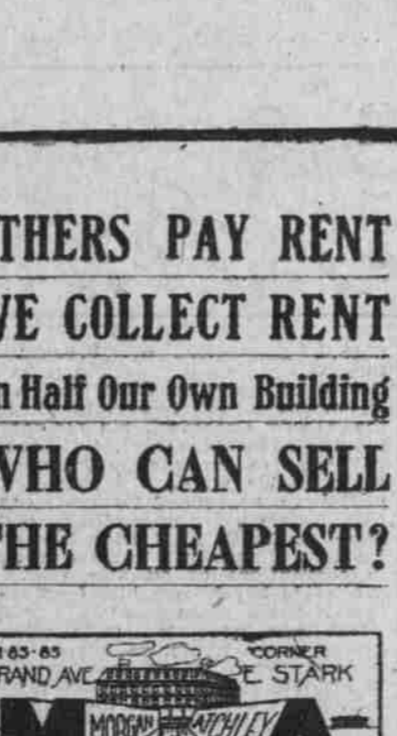
