STEARNS, Ky., Dec. 25.—Two companies of state militia are on the way to Stearns tonight, sent by Governor Wilson, on account of the rioting following the battle of yesterday, in which a deputy United States Marshal and a striking miner were killed.

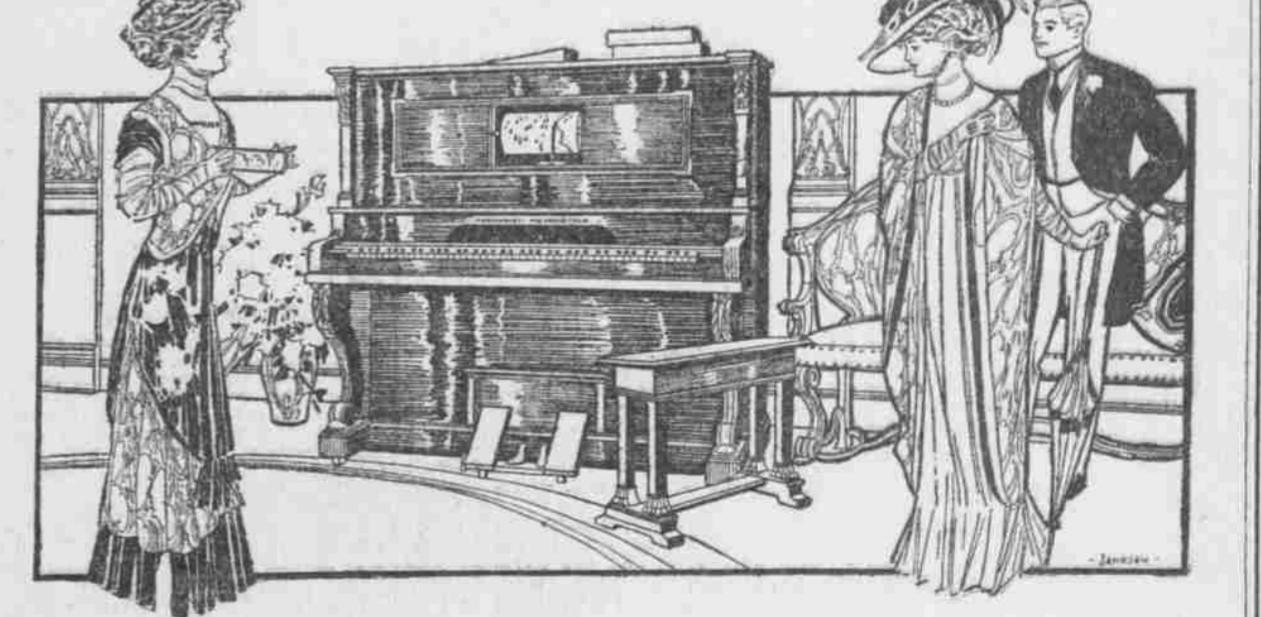
