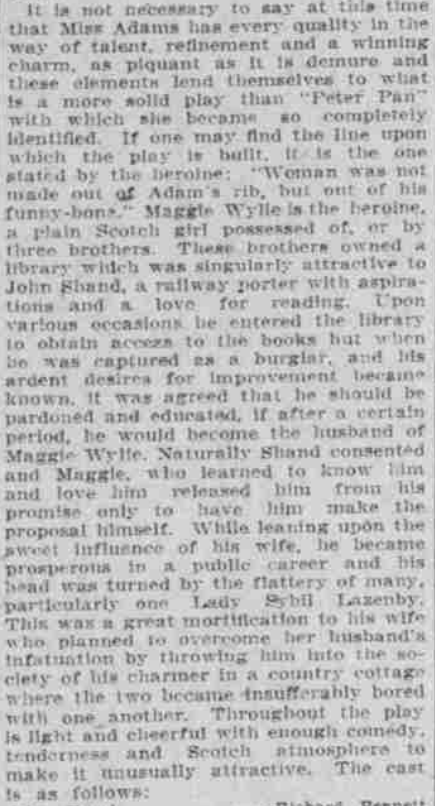

Full Text of the Johnson Road Bill, Which Will Be Taken Up by the Legislature at the Coming Session.

and Second Congressional Districts shall receive as compensation for their services the sum of one dollar (\$1) per diem for performing official duties as said Commissioners and three dollars (\$3) per diem for the time actually employed under the provisions of this act.

Sec. 3. Whenever practicable the State Highway Commission shall investigate the condition of the roads of the material in the state, ascertain the most approved methods of road construction and improvement of roads, investigate the condition of the roads of the state, road building in other states and hold public meetings throughout the state for the purpose of ascertaining the means for better roads, when such is deemed advisable. On or before December 21, 1919, and biennially thereafter, they shall make a report to the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly, stating as near as possible the number of miles of roads built during the preceding biennial period, the total amount and location of all "main highways" improved under this act. Also the general character and location of the roads of the state, the construction, the general character and needs of the roads of the state, and recommend such legislation as it deems advisable and proper to improve the roads of the state, and prove that it may deem expedient.

use of the available road material throughout the several parts of the state and the best methods of road construction as far as the same may be practicable, it shall cause the State Road Engineer to prepare a plan of road classification, construction and improvement of the "main highways" throughout the state as shall be most suitable to the requirements of, and bring the most practical results to, the several parts of the state. The plan shall be printed and several copies thereof shall be forwarded to the County Clerks of the several counties of the state for proper distribution.

Section 2. After the receipt thereof by the County Court, they shall have published a notice to interested persons of the contemplated action, stating therein the date for such persons to appear in the County Courtroom, at a time not less than ten days after the date of such publication, to present objections, if any, to the proposed improvements, and following such hearing if they again approve the improvement, they shall adopt a final resolution setting forth that such improvements are to be constructed in the manner instructed or improved as per said plans and specifications and under the provisions of this act and shall thereupon transmit a certified copy of such final resolution to the State Engineer.

such overlap, taking into consideration the additional benefits, if any, accruing to such lands by reason of the improvements of each road respectively.

Secondly, the County will determine the benefits when confirmed by the County Court shall be final and shall constitute a first lien upon the real estate against which benefits are assessed, which lien shall relate back and bind the said real estate so assessed, from the time of the recording of the County Court's order. The County Court declaring the improvement, The County Court shall order that the assessment of benefits against all such lands shall be entered in a book known as the "Highway Improvement Lien Docket"

Section 12. The words "main highway," whenever used in this act, shall be construed to include all bridges upon, or which form a part of, the said "main highway" to be constructed or improved; provided, that no more than one-fourth of the state's portion of such improvement shall be expended for bridges upon any main highway so being improved.

Section 13. The State Highway Commission may, if they deem it expedient,
