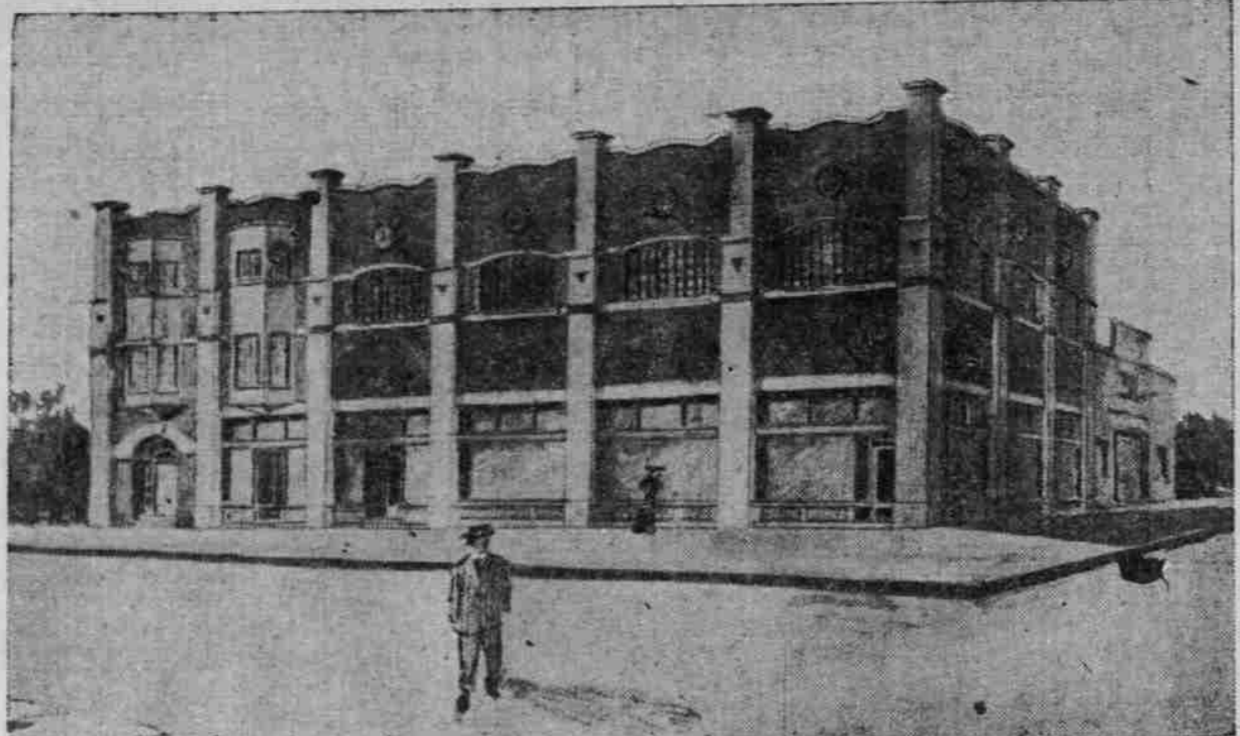
Democrat in, but Many Retired. "It puts a Democrat in office for life," was the persistent answer of opponents to the measure.

JEW REFUSES CITIZENSHIP

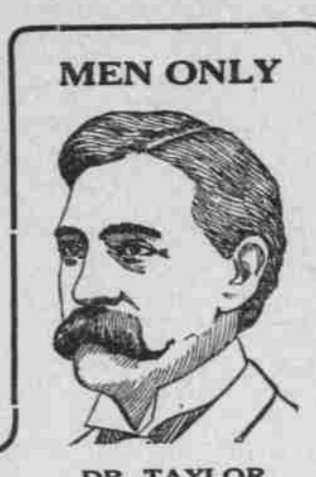
Could Not Then Return to Russia and Ask for Protection.
