WILL NOT ACCEPT FERRY

COURT REFUSES TO OPERATE ST. JOHN BOAT.

Judge Webster Declares Craft Seized by Officials Is Not Fit for Active Service.

An unusual dilemma confronts the St. John officials over the purchase of a ferryboat for operation between St. John and Linnton. The officials have picked up what they consider a fine bargain in the vessel. And the County Court declines to operate this particular boat.

The whole St. John Council, headed by Recorder A. M. Esson, was closeted yesterday with Judge Webster for a couple of hours, trying to effect a compromise, but no solution of the difficulty was reached. The St. John delegation wanted to buy the second-hand craft and the Court would not consent to operate it.
