

WANTS TUG CRUISER

Captain Sutherland Makes Offer for Boat.

SERVICE ON PUGET SOUND

Craft Is Owned by Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway and Is Now Tied Up at Vancouver. News of Waterfront.

Captain Sutherland, of Seattle, made an offer yesterday to the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway officials for the purchase of the tug Cruiser, now tied up at Vancouver, Wash. The boat has been offered for sale but the figure demanded was in excess of what Captain Sutherland was willing to pay.

The Cruiser was used as a tender during the construction of the Willamette River bridge. Since the completion of that structure, she has been idle.

Captain Sutherland was formerly owner of the tug Grayling which has been sold for service at Panama.

DRY RECORD IS ESTABLISHED

Rainfall for Past Month Less Than One Inch.

April, 1909, broke all records in 49 years for deficiency in rainfall. During the 30 days only 50 inches fell and only on seven days did rain fall.
