OREGON'S CLIMATE.

It May Be Changeable, but It Doesn't Fool the Farmer Much.

Oregon's climate is erratic at times. It sometimes appears to have forgotten itself, but the optimistic webfoot usually notices that it may be depended upon to do the right thing at the right time.

It can be depended upon to bring strawberries, roses, cherries, apples, peaches, pears, melons and grapes in persistent regularity and profusion.

Gradually the large farm holdings are being broken up and divided into 5 and 10-acre tracts. A striking illustration of this is the famous old Broadmead farm, located in Yamhill and Polk counties on the Southern Pacific and the projected McMinnville branch of the Oregon Electric road.

At the present time the townsite of "Broadmead" is being laid out by the Columbia Trust Company, at the junction of the two converging lines, and great activity is shown over the entire tract of 2500 acres.

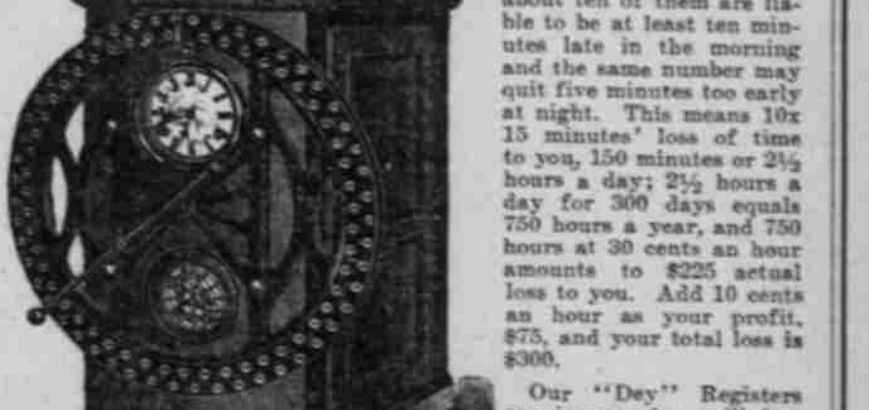
