CLIMAX IS REACHED

Calhoun Trial Great Event in Graft Prosecution.

REMARKABLE FOR LENGTH

Will Rank With Historic Trials for Time Occupied—Trenchery in Ranks of Prosecution and Raids by Officers.

SAN FRANCISCO, June 19.—The trial of Patrick Calhoun has been one of the longest and most sensational in Western history, being only surpassed by the Beecher-Tilton trial in New York, the Standard Oil hearings in many cities in the dissolution proceedings and the Tichborne trial in England in the '70s. It required 186 days of actual court sessions to secure the jury, and in that time 3710 talesmen were summoned and 1422 interrogated. Empanelling of jurors began on January 12 and was completed on April 14, when a 12th juror was sworn to avoid risk of a mistrial by the death of or illness of one of the 12. Six of the jurors have been practical prisoners at the St. Francis Hotel since March 9. The trial is estimated to have cost \$50,000, and the record includes 4,530,000 words, of which 2,500,000 were spoken in the examination of witnesses.

Crusade Against Bribery.

The trial is the climax of a crusade begun by J. J. Heney, backed financially by Rudolph Spreckels, J. D. Phelan and others, against bribery in the city government of San Francisco. In November, 1908, Mr. Heney publicly charged Al Ruff, the boss, and Eugene Schmitz, the Mayor, with corruption. W. J. Burns, a Government secret service agent, was employed to secure the evidence. In March, 1907, he trapped Charles Boxton, Edward I. Walsh and Thomas Lonergan, Supervisors, into accepting bribes, and with this leverage extorted confessions which implicated Ruff, Schmitz and all the other Supervisors, with one or two exceptions. The confessions showed that the United Railways Company had paid \$200,000 for a trolley franchise, that the Pacific States Telephone Company paid to have a franchise refused to its rival, the Home, and that the Home paid to secure a franchise which it did not get; that restaurant-keepers and keepers of disreputable houses paid blackmail for immunity from prosecution; that a syndicate of fight promoters paid bribes to secure a monopoly.
