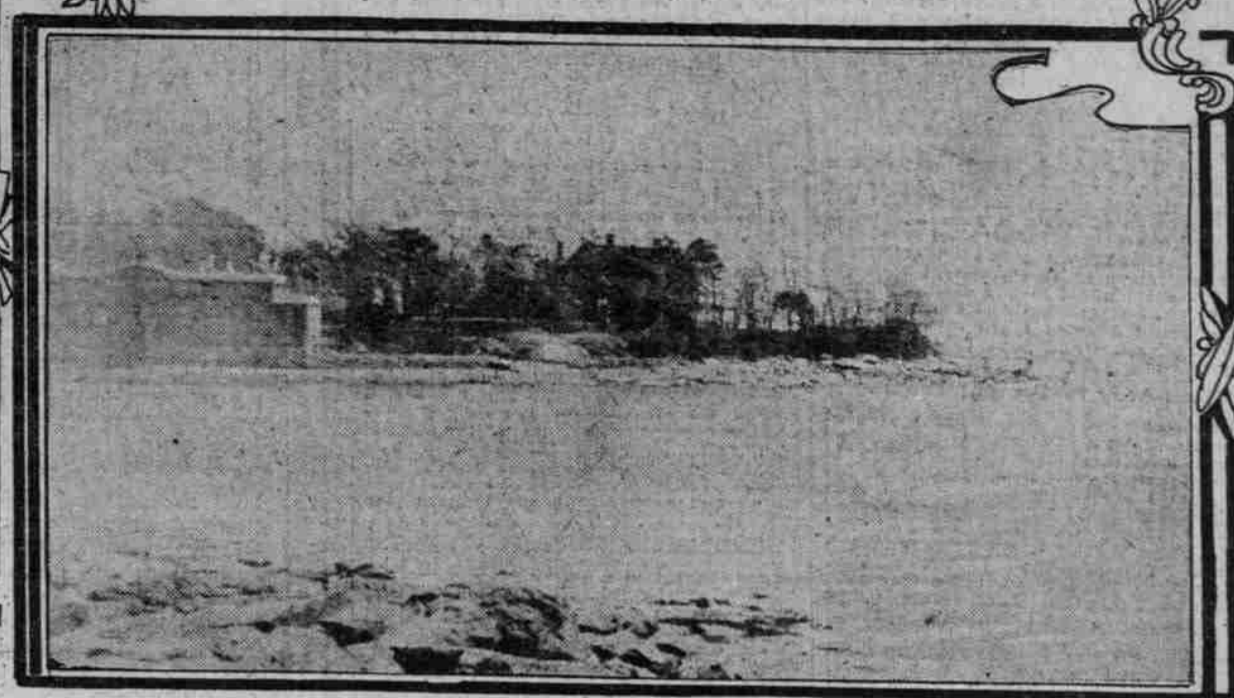

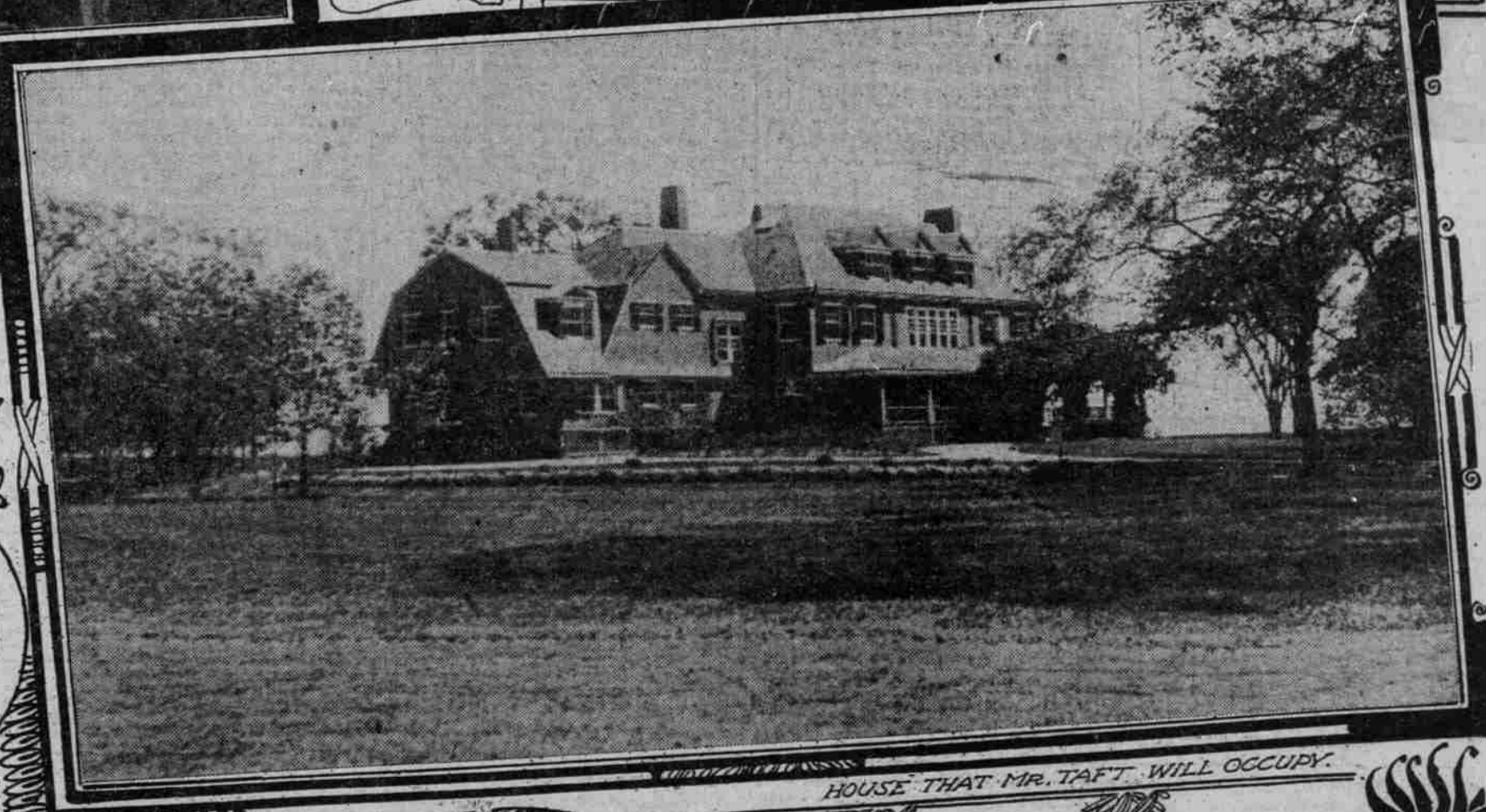

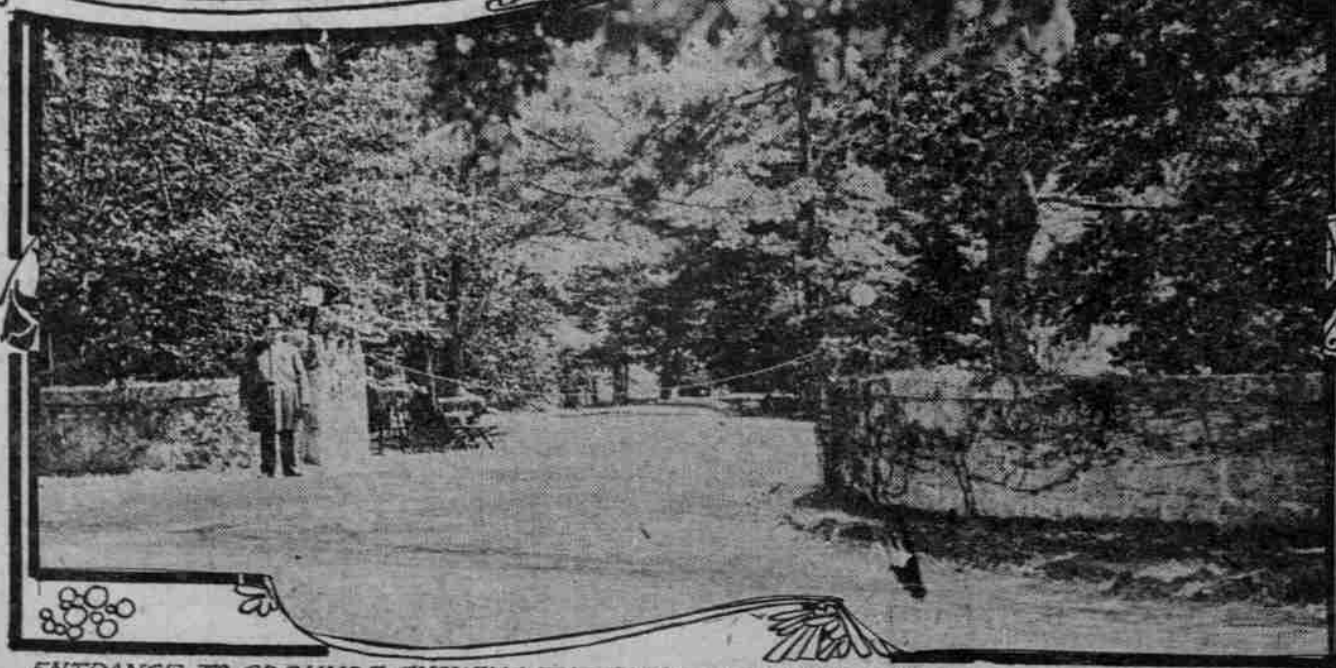


HOUSE THAT MR. TAFT WILL OCCUPY.

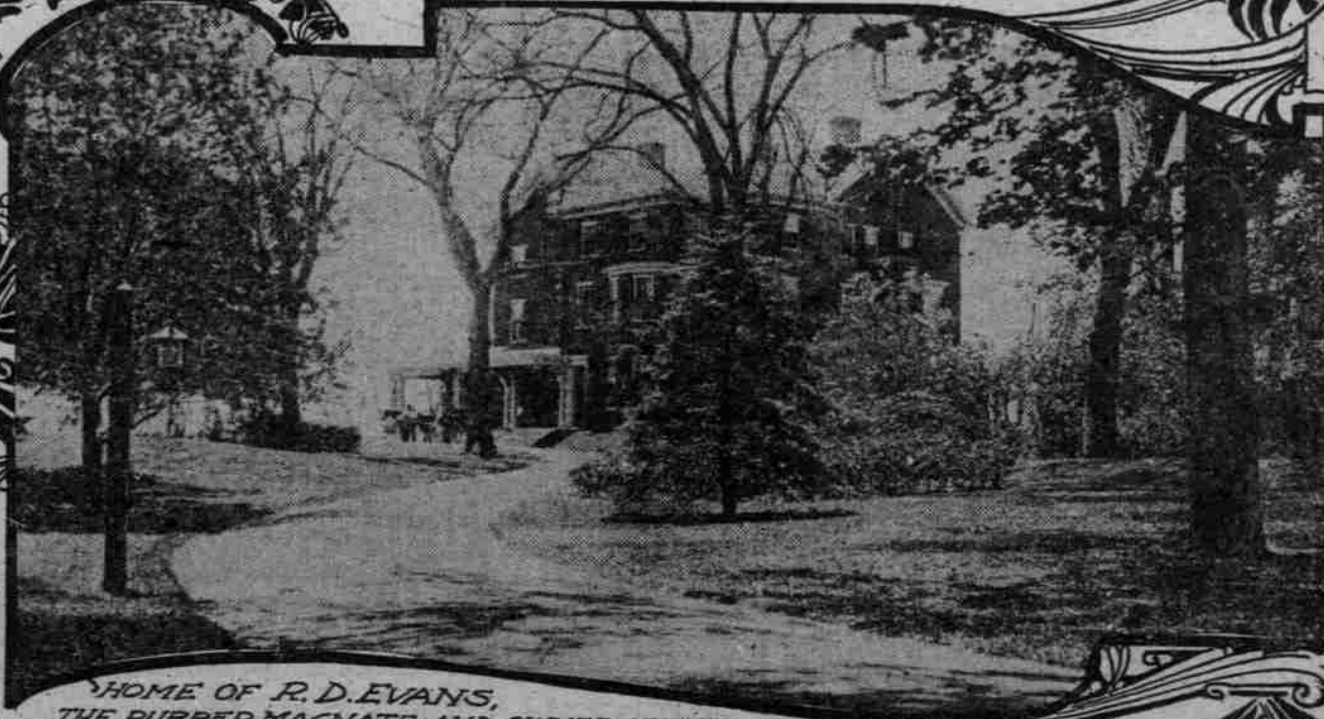
