In this sale we have positively no jurisdiction over the prices and no interest whatsoever in the selling, being guided entirely by the instructions from the Poughkeepsie Queen Undermuslins Co.
We will say this much, that the prices they have instructed us to sell this muslin underwear at, is a great deal less than the goods cost to manufacture, and is without doubt the biggest muslin underwear bargain ever offered to the shoppers of the City of Portland. These goods are displayed in three Third-street windows at three prices, namely, 25c, 85c, and \$1.29. On sale Monday.
