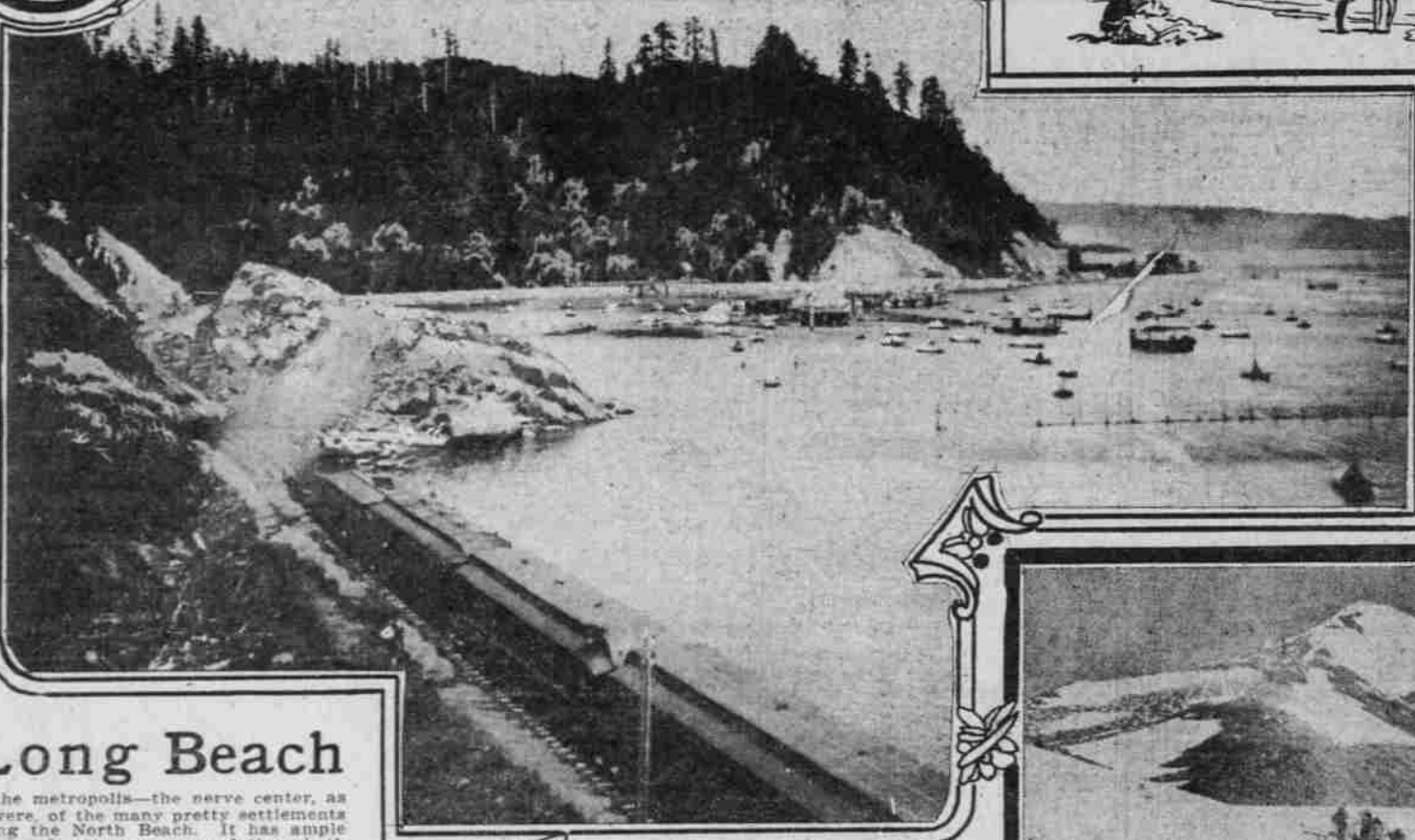

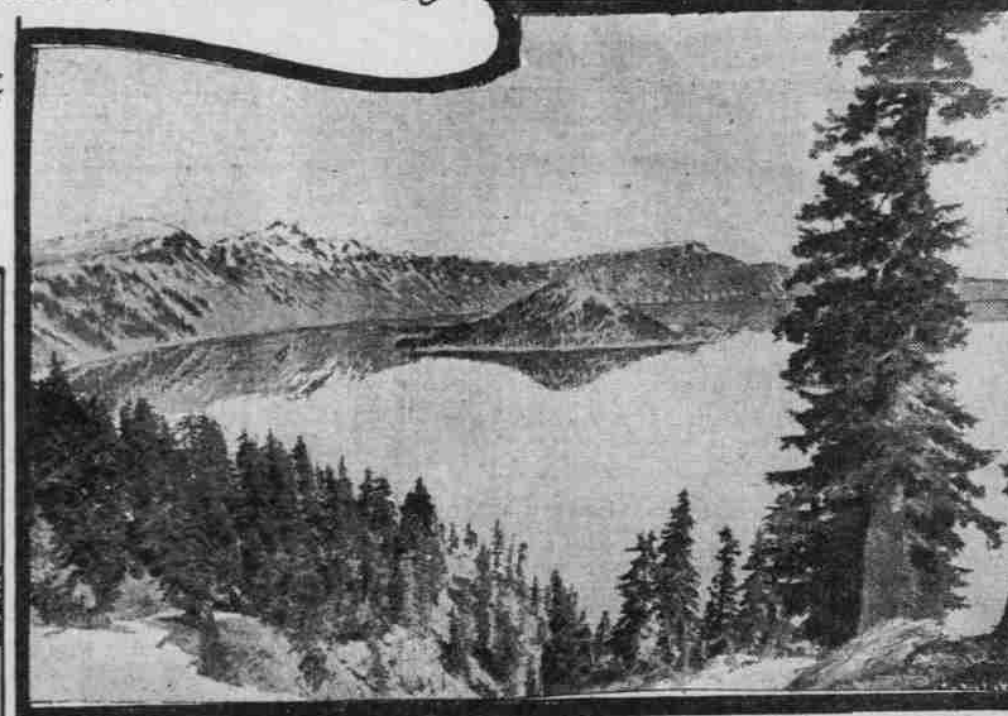


Crater Lake

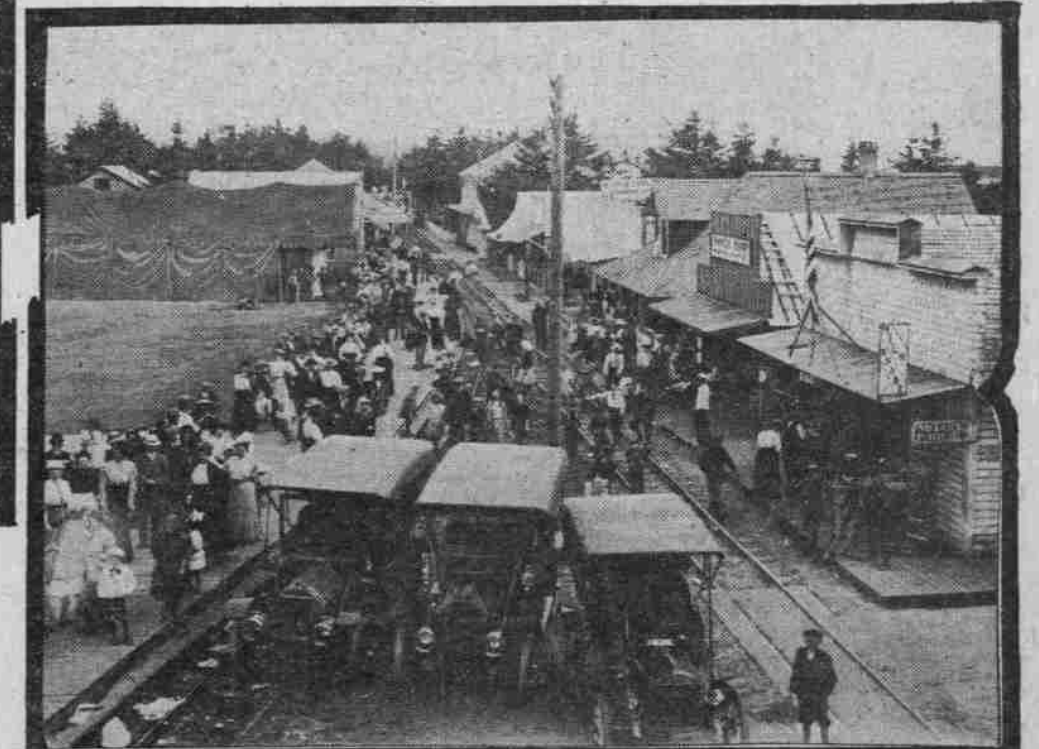
