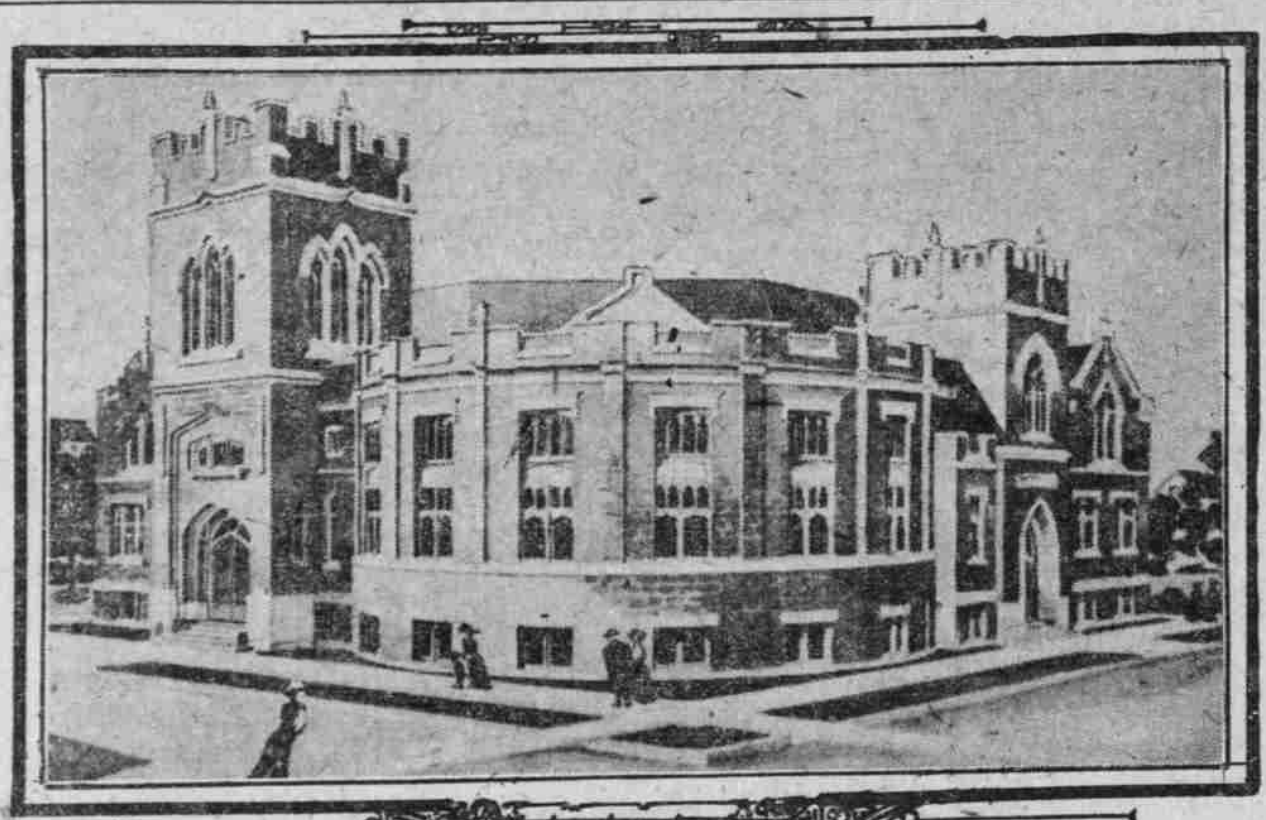


CORNERSTONE OF NEW CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH AT SUNNYSIDE IS TO BE LAID

Exercises Consecrating Start of Handsome Sandstone Edifice Will Be Held Today—Rev. J. J. Staub Has Been Pastor Fifteen Years.



SUNNYSIDE CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH

THE cornerstone of the new edifice of the Sunnyside Congregational Church, now being erected on the corner of East Taylor and East Thirty-second streets, will be laid this afternoon at 2 o'clock, with appropriate ceremonies. The programme of exercises will be as follows:

Scripture reading, prayer, address, Rev. Luther R. Bryant, D. D., pastor of the First Congregational Church of this city; solo, Miss Allie Fowler; address, Judge John B. Cleland; solo, selected; address, Samuel Connolly; placing the cornerstone, W. S. Shalan and E. W. Minar; placing of contents in the cornerstones by S. C. Pier, clerk of the church; Bible, copies of denominational papers, including the Congregationalist, Advance and Pacific; copies of Portland dailies, The Oregonian, Telegram and Journal; history of the Sunnyside Congregational Church, list of present membership, list of donors to date, programme of today's exercises; dedication of the cornerstone by S. O. Woods, chairman of the building committee, and Rev. J. J. Staub, pastor of the church.

It is desired to hold the exercises on the first floor of the new church, but should the weather be unfavorable the programme will be given in the old church, corner of East Thirty-fourth and East Taylor streets.

comfortably 1200 people, which may be increased to 2000 on special occasions. It is divided into the main auditorium and the lecture room, separated by a folding partition. The lecture room is for the Sunday school, and contains a number of class rooms.

A modern plan was studied out carefully for the auditorium, so the speaker can see every one in the audience, whether in the floor or in the gallery. The walls are being built of sandstone from the foundation up. The main entrance tower will be on East Taylor street and will be 50 feet high, and with the rest of the church will be finished with battlement effect. Another entrance will be on East Taylor street. It is expected to have the building inclosed by the first of the year. The cost of the structure is estimated about \$90,000. The organ now in use in the old building will be enlarged and used in the new, for it is practically a new instrument.

This church has had only one pastor since it was organized 15 years ago in Meade hall. Rev. J. J. Staub, and his pastorate has broken the record of that of any congregational minister in this state. The success that has attended his work in Portland has been due to his practical common sense and good judgment, and the unanimous support and co-operation of the membership. Plans for the new church were drawn with a view to the erection of a thoroughly modern church in every way. The space, largely according to the suggestions of Rev. Mr. Staub.
