—The old way of cutting glass was to make the shape, and on the plain surface of the glass etch the design. This was then put against a revolving wheel until the deep cutting was even, fine and perfect. It was then polished by hand.

—Today there is another process. They mould the glass with the indentation or pattern moulded in it, then take this and lay it against a wheel to finish off and cut out anything that is round; this is then polished and sold for cut glass.

—Between the two kinds of cutting there is simply no comparison. ONE IS BRILLIANT AND LUSTROUS AND KEEPS ITS BRILLIANCY, the other is lustrous, BUT IT LACKS THE BRILLIANCY OF THE OLD-FASHIONED CUT, AND COSTS MUCH LESS TO PRODUCE.
