CHRISTIAN MICHELSEN CLEARS
Norwegian Steamship Takes Lumber for Shanghai, China.

Carrying 2,960,000 feet of lumber, valued at \$32,350, the Norwegian steamship Christian Michelsen cleared yesterday for Shanghai.

Lumber exports, foreign, for the month of November amount to 9,175,952 feet. The month will round out with close to 5,000,000 feet additional, which will bring export figures almost up to past records.
