TWO BANKERS INDICTED

Oklahoma City Officials Give Heavy Bail on Numerous Charges.

OKLAHOMA CITY, Okla., Aug. 12.—Abner Davis, formerly president of the Night and Day Bank, and owner of the Oklahoma City baseball franchise in the Texas League, and F. H. Myers, ex-cashier of the bank, were indicted here today, 13 joint indictments in all being returned against them. Two of the indictments charge making false entries; two charge embezzlement and one accuses the former bank officers of making false reports to the State Banking Board.

Americans in Paris Mourn Loss of John W. Gates.

PARIS, Aug. 12.—The funeral of John W. Gates was held today at the Interdenominational American Church in Rue de Berry. The service was conducted by Rev. James Lee, pastor of St. John's Methodist Episcopal Church, South, assisted by Dr. Hyatt, pastor of the American Church, who was a boyhood playmate of Mr. Gates, but had never met him in later life. About 200 American friends and acquaintances of the family from all parts of the United States were present. The body will be taken to Cherbourg Tuesday and placed on board the Kaiser Wilhelm der Grosse, which will sail on the following day for New York. Mrs. Gates and Charles G. Gates will accompany the body.
