

## Large Modern Sanitary Market to Be Erected in Portland

H. S. Warren & Co. and associates of Detroit, Michigan, are having plans prepared by Bennes & Hendricks, local architects, for a seven story building to cover Block 68 as indicated by the black space in map herewith shown. Building to be Class A, reinforced concrete; basement to be occupied by refrigerated store rooms for market merchants; first floor to be occupied entirely by stall spaces, which will give about 32,000 square feet for market purposes. Approximate cost of building and equipment is \$300,000
