KEY TO ILLUSTRATIONS.

- 1—Croton Aqueduct, under construction from the Catskills to the heart of New York, is 110 miles long and will cost \$168,000,000. It is one of the most stupendous works in history of engineering.
- 2—This is the largest locomotive in the world. It is being tested by the Pennsylvania Railroad.
- 3—Funeral of Admiral Evans. Petty officers of dispatchboat Dolphin are carrying body from house to artillery caisson.
- 4—Gunboat Yorktown, which has been sent to Ecuador to protect interests of American citizens in political uprising.
- 5—New Museum of Art at Toledo, which was opened last Wednesday. Twenty thousand citizens gave \$250,000 to build it.
- 6—Paris police at tomb of Mile. Lanthelmoor, famous French beauty, from which attempt was made to steal \$80,000 necklace. The thieves failed to find the jewels in the tomb, the value of which was not so great as supposed.
- 7—This is novel motor sledge, which Captain Robert Scott took with him on Polar search. It may have pushed its way to South Pole.
- 8—Ermanno Wolf-Ferrari and his wife arriving in New York early this month to witness the production of his opera, "Le Donne Curioso." Gattie Casazza is on the right.
