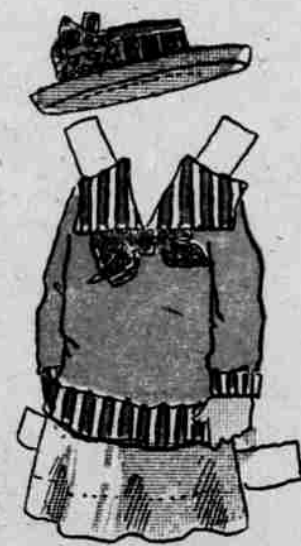


ANNA BELLE GOES FOR A HAY RIDE
