

RARE GIFTS ARE POURING IN FOR LATEST WHITE HOUSE BRIDE-TO-BE

Ambassadors Have in Most Part Selected Presents of Unique Conception—Republic of France to Observe Ancient Custom, but Nature of Gift is Secret.



WASHINGTON, Nov. 15.—(Special.)—Gifts are piling into the White House from all directions, and many notables are making the tour of the Washington shops to select suitable presents.

The chiefs of the more important missions have already forwarded their gifts. A few are awaiting the arrival of consignments from New York before making a final decision.

The Russian Ambassador and Mrs. Bakhmetoff sent one of the most unusual gifts in the collection. It is an umbrella handle formed of a semi-precious Siberian stone of pearly color held in an intricate tracery of silver, handsomely embellished with Russian enamels in many colors.
