ASHINGTON, Nov. 15 .- (Special.) -Gifts are piling into the White House from all directions, and many notables are making the tour of the Washington shops to select suitable presents.

The chiefs of the more important missions have already forwarded their gifts. A few are awaiting the arrival of consignments from New York before making a final decision. Among the interesting articles in the fast-filling giftroom at the White House is a wonderful set of four candlesticks sent by the Ambassador of Italy, Marquis Cusani Confalonieri and his wife, the Marchioness Cusani Confalonieri. Of Etruscan design, the candlesticks, which are about 12 inches high and weigh about four pounds each, are elaborately carved in an intricate design of enwreathed festoons.

The Ambassager of Germany and Countess Von Bernstorff gave Wilson two antique sugar shakers of curious design and great beauty.
