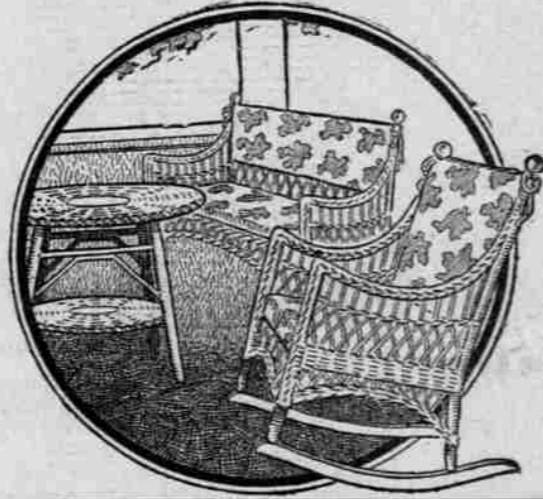

PATRIOTISM STIRRED BY CRACKED LIBERTY BELL

Visit to Scenes Famed for Events in America's Birth Calls for Analysis of Modern Fourth of July Celebrations and Their Motives.

WITH the approach of another July, the Fourth, there surges back upon my memory a series of priceless vignettes that fell to my possession many years ago, when living for a time in one of the far Eastern states. A child of the West, one may readily appreciate with what boyish eagerness I seized upon each first opportunity to visit any locality associated to matter how slightly with the history of our National Independence. I remember the traces that came over me as I entered Pancoast Hall and, sitting down in the assembly-room, fancied Samuel Adams in one of his impassioned harangues. I rested beneath the shadow of the Old Elm Tree in Cambridge, where, as recorded in a gigantic slab, "Washington first took command of the American Army."

I went up Putnam's Redoubt, clambered over the cañon, and looked down upon the Mystic, where British men-of-war can no longer ride at anchor. I rambled over the green-awards of Bunker Hill and traced the low ridge still marking the line of the intrenchments. Gaining up into the handsome face of General Warren's statue, I felt myself being almost mesmerized into thinking that those bronze tips were repeating for me "Don't shoot, boys, till you see the whites of their eyes." I climbed the stairs up into the belfry of Christ Church and peered down from the very window where the banners were hung to wear Paul Revere. Yes, and I followed that midnight dash, up through the hills of Arlington and on into Lexington and stopped there on the village green, half wondering if I might not still hear that menacing cry, "Disperse, ye rebels. Lay down your arms."

I passed on to Concord and, moved by the little stream with the fame so big. The figure of the Minute Man haunts me now, with those unforgettable lines on the pedestal: By the route price that ascended the road, Their flag to April's breeze alofted. Here first the emmetted farmers stood, And from the shot towers 'round the world, One Fourth of July I was one of an excursion party on a steamer down the Potomac to spend the day at Mount Vernon. My eyes brimmed large with tears when, all unexpectedly, the hull of the steamboat began to fall and the military band on board hushed its revelry to play the majestic chords of "My Country, 'tis of Thee" for we were opposite the resting place of that "First in the hearts of his countrymen." In the city of Washington I saw the original first copy, in Thomas Jefferson's own handwriting, of our Magna Charta. And, down in Pennsylvania, I strolled about the battlefield of Germantown and over the site of that dread Winter encampment of Valley Forge.

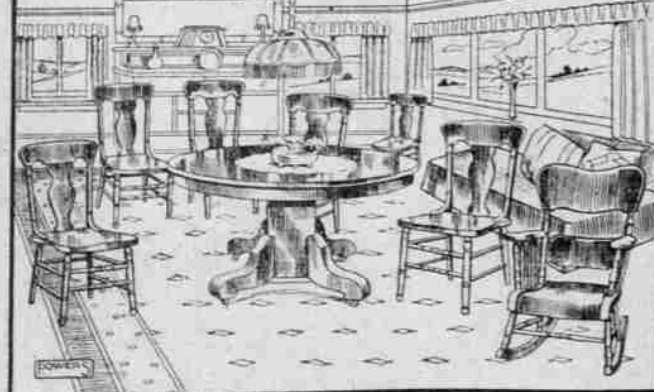

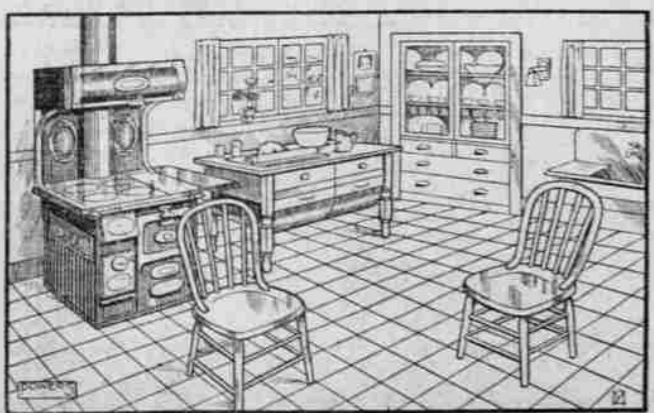
