DEPOSED CLEVELAND MANAGER ASKS \$20,000 DAMAGES.

Action Brought Against Owner Somers Based on "Ironclad" Contract Minus Ten-day Clause.

CLEVELAND, O., July 10.—Joseph L. Birmingham, former manager of the Cleveland American League baseball club, today filed suit for \$20,000 in common pleas court here against Charles W. Somers, owner of the team, to recover salary and damages alleged to be due because Somers terminated his contract, discharged him as manager and released him as a member of the team.

Birmingham's petition says his contract was for the seasons of 1914, 1915 and 1916 at \$6000 a year, with \$1500 additional as an option on his services, and that it contained no ten-day clause, being what has come to be termed an "ironclad" contract. He says he was paid his salary to June 1, 1915, and contends it is due until October 15, 1916.

The suit is expected to be a test of the so-called "ironclad" contract, which displaced the ten-day clause after certain court decisions held the latter invalid after the Federal League entered the field.
