FOR DISPOSING OF LAND

H. N. Lawrie Submits Plan on Railway Grants to Secretary of Interior.

SEGREGATION IS PROPOSED

Mining Geologist Suggests When Land is Sold for Agricultural Purposes Mineral Rights Be Reserved for Separate Sale.

A comprehensive plan for disposing of the property involved in the Oregon & California land grant, as well as that involved in the Oregon Southern grant, has been evolved by H. N. Lawrie, chairman of the Oregon Bureau of Mines and Geology Commission, who has submitted his idea to Franklin K. Lane, Secretary of the Interior.

An important provision in Mr. Lawrie's plan makes segregation of the lands according to their natural resources. He would make separate disposition of the water-power area, of the agricultural lands, of the grazing and waste lands and of the mineral resources.
