The automatic machinery and the simplicity of operations will be interesting to persons not familiar with this work.

Another plant that will be of interest is a mucliage and ink factory. From this plant the visitors will be taken to a rubber factory where they will see the equipment for making articles used in everyday life that up to less than two years ago were brought from far-away points.

Few people realize that Portland possesses laundry plants that are examples of efficiency for the entire country. This was brought out at the recent National convention held here by the laundrymen of the United States. A visit to one of the newer plants is a lesson in time and labor saving to the housewives of Oregon, and the managers of these institutions always have the latchstring out to visitors.
