

CONSULS PUT UNDER SEARCHING INQUIRY

ACTIVITIES IN DISFAVOR

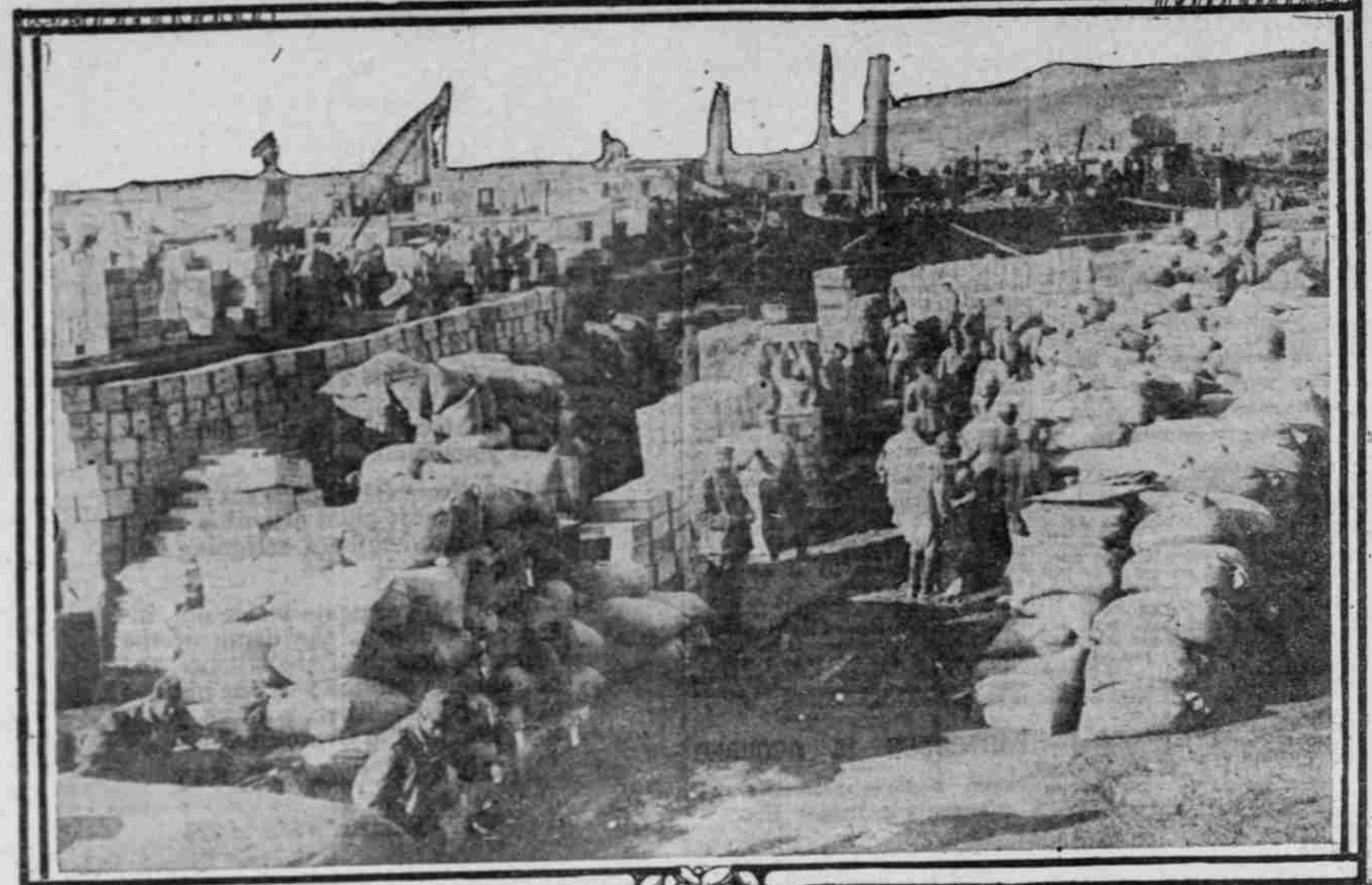
Washington Will Not Be Content With Removal of Boy-Ed and Von Papan From Office—Banishment Will Be Insisted On.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 4.—Developments which have followed the request for withdrawal of Captain Boy-Ed and Captain Franz von Papan, naval and military attaches of the German Embassy, indicated today that the State Department would conduct a wide investigation of foreign consular officials in the United States whose suspected activities in some instances are looked on with extreme disfavor.

Case of Von Nuber Undecided.

It was said at the department tonight that no decision had been reached in the case of Alexander von Nuber, Austro-Hungarian Consul-General at New York, whose name frequently has been mentioned in connection with the activities of Boy-Ed and von Papan.
