

DRY LAW BRINGS UP VARIOUS PROBLEMS

Washington Wholesale Liquor Men to Bring Action Based on Property Rights.

APPLE POOL IS CLOSED ENFORCEMENT IS QUESTION

Powers of Governor Lister, Should Local Officials Fall in Duty, Are Not Clear—Many New Legal Phases Unsettled.

OLYMPIA, Wash., Dec. 11.—(Special.)—Although the Supreme Court decision yesterday, upholding the prohibition law, is not the actual adoption of the act at the last general election, the most important step in making Washington dry, that condition has not yet been attained.

At least one more local action attacking the validity of the prohibition measure is to be instituted after the first of the year, and it is probable that this latter action will be taken through to the Supreme Court of the United States.

There are a multitude of other questions as to provisions in the act, affecting principally the consumer, which will be considered by the court only after they are actually raised in a criminal action, after the law has gone into effect.

Personal Appearance Questioned. Still another is the question of whether it is discrimination in favor of the resident of the county...

After the law is put in effect the question of its enforcement remains. Governor Lister has promised flatly that the law will be enforced throughout the state.

Just how the Governor is to take steps to enforce the prohibition law where local sentiment is against it or where local officers fail to act is not clearly clear. Governor Lister intends having in the matter a close personal supervision.

Liquor Stocks Prohibited. The most immediate problem raised by the law taking effect will be the disposal of liquor in the state on January 1.

Approximately \$700,000 in annual revenue from state, county and city liquor licenses will be lost through the prohibition law taking effect.
