PENDLETON, Or., May 27.—(Spe-cial.)—In a decision handed down to-application of Attorneys Fee & Fee for Mayor Best, who sought by mandamus proceedings to compel Justice of the Peace Joe H. Parkes to transfer to Filot Rock the action in which the Mayor is charged with the use of im-proper language in a public place.

Municipal Comfort Station Planned.


