Opposition Found to Present Engineer Being on Highway Commission.

FUTURE FRICTION FEARED

When Legislature Meets and Considers Road Legislation, Effort to Abolish Mr. Lewis' Office Is Not Deemed Unlikely.

By abolishing the office, it will be argued, a large sum will be saved the state and a positive step taken in the elimination of needless state offices and commissions.

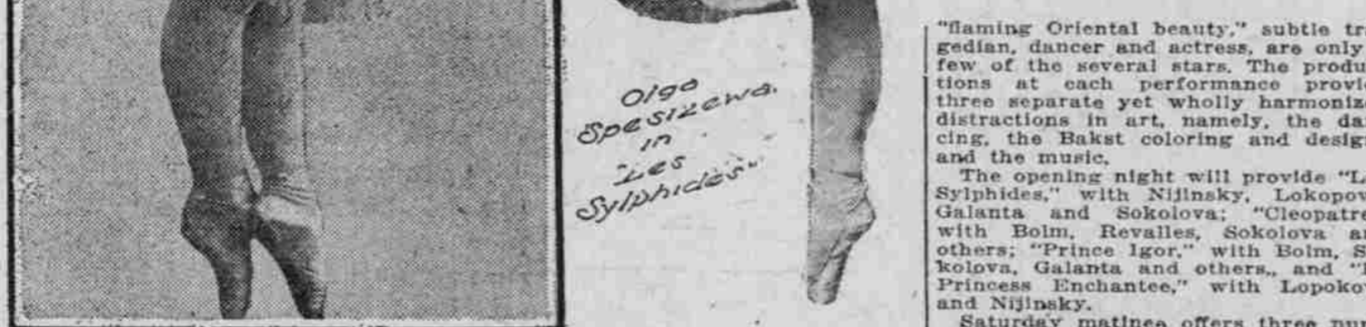
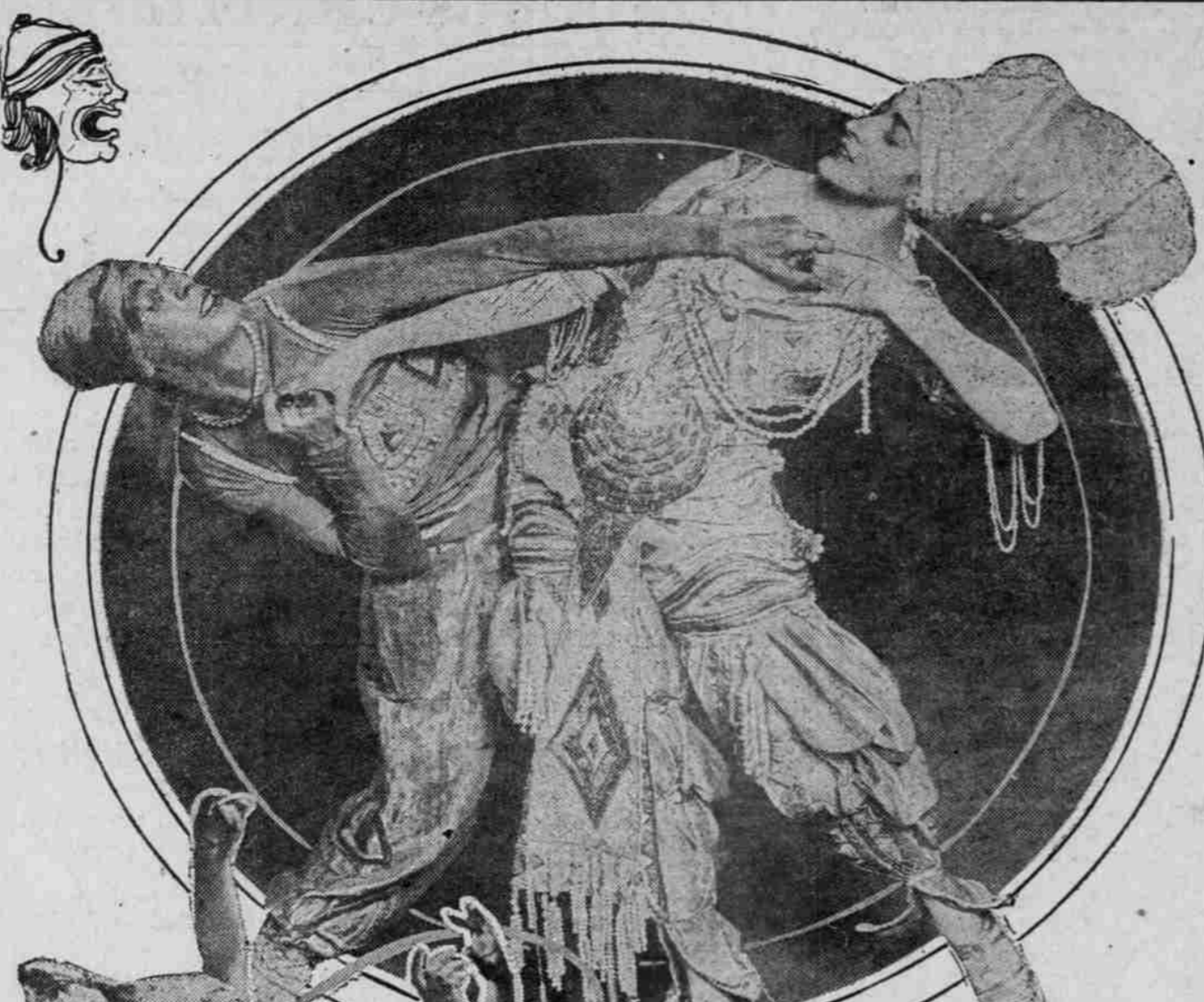
