FOLLOWING is the complete text of Oregon "bone-dry" prohibition bill as finally passed by the Legislature and signed by Governor Withycombe: A bill for an act to amend sections 5, 6, 13 and 35 of an act entitled "An Act to Prohibit the Importation of Intoxicating Liquor into the State of Oregon..."

(a) The District Attorney of any district in this state shall on application issue to persons residing in the district for which he shall have been elected permits to purchase or import into this state intoxicating liquor as follows: To retail druggists, a manufacturer of other than retail druggists such manufacturers being actually engaged in the manufacture of such liquor...

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to import into this state any quantity of alcohol to be diluted or adulterated or combined with any other substance in such a manner that it shall be capable of being used as a beverage...

(c) It shall be the duty of the County Clerk of each county of the state to prepare and keep on hand blank forms for such affidavits, which shall be bound detachably in books or books of 100 each...

(d) It shall be the duty of every pharmacist to keep all permits, prescriptions and affidavits filed by him under this act on file. Such file shall be open for the inspection of any officer at any time during business hours...

(e) It shall be unlawful for any person other than a common carrier keeping such records and complying with the provisions of this act to bring, introduce or deliver any intoxicating liquor into this state, and it shall be unlawful for any agent of such carrier to do so...

(f) The provisions of this act shall not be construed to prevent the making or selling of vinegar, alcohol, medicinal wine, or any other medicinal or actually denatured under the laws and regulations of the United States Government...

(g) Registered pharmacists conducting or employed in retail drug stores may sell ethyl alcohol for medicinal, manicure or dental purposes, to persons to whom permits or prescriptions may have been issued in compliance with the terms of this act...

(h) Every manufacturer referred to in this subdivision as entitled to permits for the purchase or importation of ethyl alcohol shall, before receiving any such permit, present to the District Attorney of the county in which he is located a bond running to the state of Oregon in the penal sum of \$2500...

(i) Except as hereinbefore provided, it shall be unlawful for any person within this state to receive, import, transport or otherwise bring into this state any quantity of alcohol...

(j) Except as hereinbefore provided, it shall be unlawful for any person to sell, transport or otherwise bring out of this state any quantity of alcohol...

(k) In every sale of alcohol by a wholesaler, the wholesaler shall take up the package containing the alcohol and cancel the permit on which such sale is made, and not later than the tenth day of each calendar month...

(l) The County Clerk of each county where such registered pharmacist has his place of business, or is so employed, shall, on application, issue to such pharmacist a permit to sell ethyl alcohol for medicinal, manicure or dental purposes, to persons to whom permits or prescriptions may have been issued in compliance with the terms of this act...
