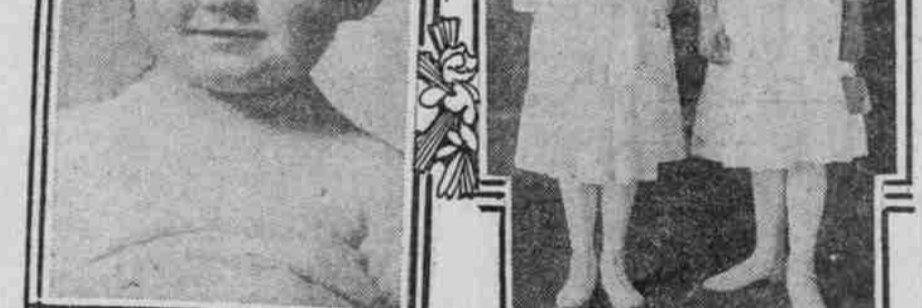

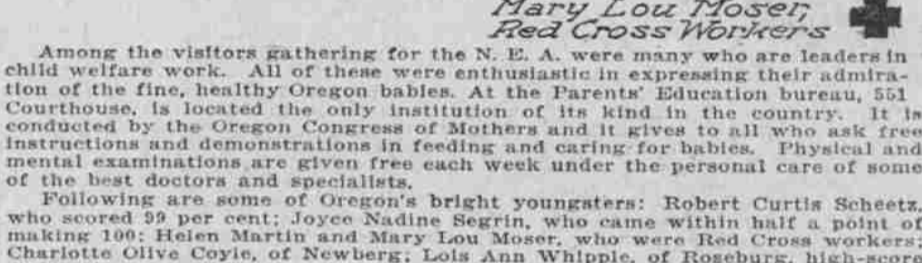

Human Institutions and Divine Authority.

We believe that a man must be called of God, by prophecy, and by the laying on of hands by those who are in authority to preach the gospel and baptize the repentant in the ordinances thereof.

Organization is essential to human advancement. The divine affirmation that it is not good for man to be alone may be applied not only to the union of the sexes, but to the union of individuals to associate themselves in any organization having worthy purpose.

Churches, societies or other associations established on purely human initiative are institutions of men; they can never be authorized by God, and with consistency that such organizations bear the names of men, or that they be known by some appellation expressive of their origin.

The church of the apostolic epoch was the organization that Christ had established. He very expressly called it My Church (Matt. xviii), and after his departure, every ordinance therein was administered in the name of Jesus Christ.

The acts of a public official, whether of local or National status, are effective only within the limits of the jurisdiction he represents. City ordinances can be enforced within the boundaries of the municipality, but not beyond.

All covenants, contracts, bonds, obligations, oaths, vows, performances, connections, associations, or expectations that are not made and entered into and sealed by the Holy Spirit of promise of him who is anointed, shall in no way bound, or give effect to, in any manner, in any court of man, and shall be null and void.
