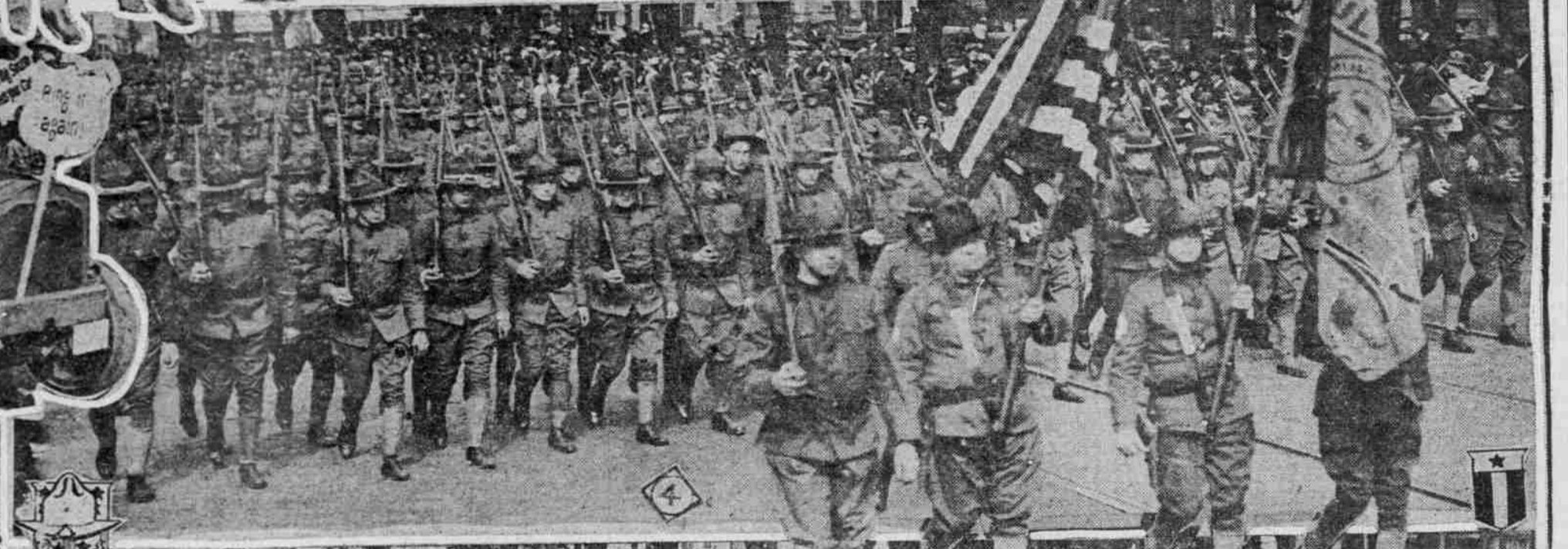


# GLIMPSES OF PORTLAND'S BIG WAR ACTIVITIES PARADE HELD YESTERDAY
