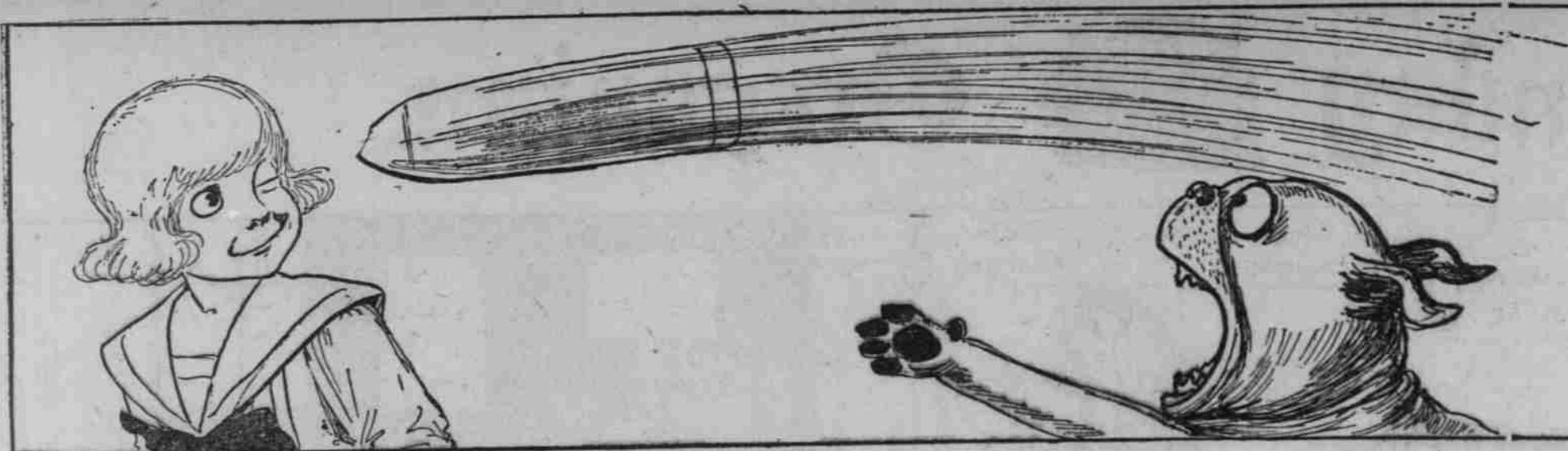




Dear Eddie
