Portland Nearing Another Liberty Loan Record; Dash for Quota Goal is On.

FINAL ONSLAUGHT HEAVY At Liberty Temple Leaders Are Making Thorough Preparation for Wiping Out Deficit; Disappointment Expressed.

are disappointed, as are their thousands of workers, at the failure of the city to report victory yesterday, on the official opening of the liberty drive. But they are far from downcast. Complete reliance is placed in the plans which are to be utilized tomorrow, and in the fact that Portland has been for the first time thoroughly awakened to the fact of failure.

"I am keenly disappointed in the outcome of the drive," said Chairman Olin yesterday. "When the drive was launched I anticipated that Portland would come to bat as in all previous drives, but the city has failed us. It was not in the cards that we should win, and that is all there is to it.

"Our next work must be the checking-up of all subscriptions, to ascertain the identity of the slackers and shirkers. It is our duty to the Nation and the community. I regret to have to resort to such an expedient, but the action has been invited by the failure of thousands to express in substantial manner their loyalty to the Nation and their home city."

General Guy W. Talbot, while assured that ultimate failure is not to be thought of, insisted that Portland must rally in rapid manner if it is to aid Oregon in attaining another record for spontaneity in the liberty loan.

Everyone Constituted Committee. "Unless every man and woman in the city constitutes an individual committee to bring to the attention of the Liberty Temple, or places such people directly in touch with official solicitors, I shall deem the city fortunate if we obtain our quota before Wednesday," said General Talbot.

"If we had a large volunteer force," he continued, "to supplement the work of solicitors already in the field, if every person would regard it as a special duty to participate in a special drive, Portland would be the first city in America to subscribe its quota."

Regarding the obligation to wear the fourth liberty loan button on the subscription has been made, State Manager Robert E. Smith is insistent, declaring that it is highly important that subscribers display the little horn emblem that marks them as participants in the patriotic issue.

McAdoo Makes the Request. "Secretary of the Treasury McAdoo requests that during this drive in every liberty bond purchaser wear the button issued for that purpose," commented Manager Smith. "It is a privilege and a mark of loyalty to do so. It should be regarded in much the same light as the service flag, for it shows that you are helping our Government win the war."

"By neglecting to display the button you may create a wrong impression and set a bad example to others. In Portland and other cities and towns in which the loan is lagging it is particularly necessary that every bond subscriber wear the button. This will permit the public to identify those loyal citizens who are backing our boys in France."

"All purchasers of the fourth liberty loan bonds are, therefore, hereby instructed to wear the button continuously for the next three weeks."

Oregon's Reputation Involved. It is more than the fourth loan that Oregon has at stake in the present drive, declare leaders of the campaign, for by this test it will stand or fall in the estimate of sister states, who have come to regard Oregon as first in all patriotic calls.

Indicative of this sentiment is the message received yesterday by Edward Cookingham, state executive chairman, from Governor Lynch and Campaign Manager Weeks, of the Twelfth Federal Reserve District. The message from Mr. Weeks reads: "Governor Lynch joins me in expressing to you our confidence that the patriotic liberty loan organization of your state, composed in large part of men who have made former campaigns in the Twelfth Federal Reserve District so conspicuously successful, will show to the watching world that the Pacific states are squarely behind their sons in France. With your magnificent organization it should be possible this time to see that literally every citizen does his full duty, thus producing a substantial oversubscription without undue hardship to anyone."

Oregon Life Takes \$70,000. True to its record in every previous liberty loan campaign the Oregon Life Insurance Company, a home corporation, has invested \$50,000 in bonds of the fourth issue, reports H. R. Blauvelt, making a total of \$200,000 in the four issues.

The tuneful bugle calls that summon citizens to street rallies lead to the martial effect that now and again pervades the drive, though few hearers guess that the trim young musicians are cadets from Hill Military Academy. Four buglers have been assigned to regular duty at the noon rallies at Liberty Temple—Harold Darg, Wallace Smith and Nelson and Merton Robinson.

Japanese Respond Liberally. Japanese merchants and employees are responding liberally to the fourth liberty loan in the report brought to headquarters by workers among the Orientals. At least two firms, S. Ban Company and Telokku, have reported that every one of their employees has subscribed. S. Ban Company has taken \$16,000 in bonds, while Mr. Matsuhashi, president of Telokku, has taken \$1500 of the new bonds. M. Sakigami, Japanese Consul, Y. Nakaya, manager of S. Ban Company, and H. T. Takami, interpreter, are among those who have been active among their countrymen in the interests of Uncle Sam's bonds, it is reported.

Fire Insurance Companies Refuse. Outside fire insurance companies, without an exception to date, reports H. R. Blauvelt, chairman of the insurance committee of solicitation from foreign corporations, have refused to subscribe to the Oregon fund. Life insurance companies, to the contrary, have responded splendidly with but few notable exceptions. Complete lists of those subscribing and refusing to subscribe will be published later. Subscriptions recorded at present are as follows:

AID CAMPAIGN IS PLANNED

Emergency Loan Meeting to Be Held Tuesday to Boost Loan. An emergency aid campaign for the fourth liberty loan is to be conducted in Portland Tuesday, according to an announcement made yesterday by Mayor Baker, and every person on the streets will be expected to join in the singing of "Onward, Christian Soldiers" promptly at 7:30 o'clock in the evening. Ministers, without regard to creed or denomination, are being asked to lead the thousands expected to participate in the invocation for victory in the campaign.

The Mayor's statement follows: To the ministers of Portland: Please prepare for an emergency aid to the fourth liberty loan campaign in Portland. We call upon you in the name of our common love for our country to be responsible for seeing to it that every person in whose consciousness the religious element exists, sings "Onward, Christian Soldiers" in Portland, Tuesday night, on downtown streets, beginning at 7:30 P. M. We ask every minister, without regard to creed or denomination, to lead massed thousands as they sing in the great battle hymn as an invocation for victory in this campaign and in this world war for liberty.

Further announcements will be made direct and through the newspaper. There will be a rally and published list of ministers participating.

NORTH BEND FAR OVER QUOTA

NORTH BEND, Or., Sept. 28.—(Special.)—Chairman C. A. Smith, of the fourth liberty loan drive in this city, reports today that the city's quota of \$111,000 had been exceeded by nearly \$10,000, and that volunteer subscriptions are still pouring into headquarters. More than \$70,000 of the amount was subscribed by the 550 workers at the Kruse & Banks Shipbuilding Co. The largest individual subscription reported was made by Philip Buehner, president of the Buehner Lumber Company, who took \$1000 in bonds.

Dayton Passes Quota Mark

DAYTON, Or., Sept. 28.—(Special.)—At the close of business Thursday Dayton's subscription to the fourth liberty loan amounted to \$23,850, \$400 in excess of the amount allotted to this place. To date 250 names appear on the roll of honor. The committee which managed the third loan is in charge of the present campaign, J. L. Stuart being chairman. George Arthur Brown, of Portland, addressed a patriotic rally here Thursday night.

Quota More Than Doubled.

BEAVERTON, Or., Sept. 28.—(Special.)—The patriotism of residents of Eastern Washington County is evidenced by the report of Chairman Doy Gray, of the local fourth liberty loan committee, that this district, at 9 o'clock this morning, wholly without solicitation, had achieved a record of 236 per cent of its quota. A total of 424 subscribers had pledged \$25,400.

ASSOCIATION OF METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCHES

Morning Session of Conference Devoted to Appointments for Year.

BISHOP IS CALLED HOME

Presiding Officer Hears of Death of Son and Leaves for Salem; Rev. R. N. Avison Assumes Charge of Meeting.

Touched by the shadow of the great war, through the death of the son of Rev. W. O. Shepard, presiding bishop, the annual Oregon Methodist conference, which has marked the opening of a new era in Methodism in the state, closes today. The final sessions will be a union meeting at the Auditorium this morning and a commemorative celebration at the First Methodist Church this evening.

Before leaving for Chicago to attend the funeral of his son, Bishop Shepard announced the new appointments at the session yesterday morning and made a short address. R. N. Avison, pastor of the First Church of Salem, was present at the remaining sessions of the conference and the programme today will be conducted by W. W. Youngson, district superintendent, and a committee of laymen.

Resolutions Are Adopted. At the session yesterday morning resolutions were adopted favoring National prohibition and furtherance of the anti-cigarette and tobacco campaign. Steps were taken also to continue the fight for the proper observance of the Sabbath.

By the departure of Bishop Shepard the programme of the conference was considerably shortened. All social affairs incident to the sessions were cancelled, including the reception to have been given Friday afternoon by Mrs. Matt S. Hughes and the drive up the Columbia Highway scheduled for yesterday afternoon. Thus it will be possible to conclude the conference today, omitting the session announced for tomorrow morning of the programme.

Missionary Give Lectures. Last evening the Epworth League of the state joined in an anniversary celebration at which Dr. Youngson presided. A feature was the lecture by Dr. J. J. Kingham, a returned missionary from South India, which was illustrated by colored slides.

Following the love feast and union meeting of the Methodist churches today a mass meeting will be held at the First Church this evening in the interests of temperance. Hiram Good will preside and Dr. Clarence True Wilcox will speak. Dr. C. C. Barlick, recently appointed to the Board of Temperance, Prohibition and Public Morals in Washington, D. C., will also give an address.
