

VOTING PRECINCTS IN MULTNOMAH ARE 413

Of These 301 Are Located Inside City Limits.

ENTIRE LIST HERE GIVEN

Voters Informed Where to Cast Their Ballots in State, County and City Election Tuesday.

Multnomah County is divided into 413 voting precincts for the state and county election of next Tuesday. The highest numbered precinct is 237, there being 46 precincts ending in one-half. The West Side precincts are numbered from 1 to 299, the East Side precincts from 300 to 413, with the exception that Nos. 317 1/2 and 318 are within the city. For the convenience of voters in ascertaining where to cast their ballots the entire list of precinct locations is here given, with the suggestion that it be clipped and preserved, as it may not be published again.

Coos Bay Asks a Favor



CANDIDATE FOR JUSTICE SUPREME COURT

Portland business men and citizens are seeking the trade of the Coos Bay country. Portland never had a better opportunity to demonstrate that it is sincere in its protestations of friendship and interest in that section of Oregon than is now offered. If Portland business men want the trade of the Coos Bay country she has this opportunity to show a spirit of fairness toward that section and the remainder of Southwestern Oregon by supporting JUDGE JOHN S. COKE for Justice of the Supreme Court to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Justice Frank A. Moore. Of the seven justices of the Supreme Court not one is from that entire part of Western Oregon south of Eugene. Five of the seven justices are from the Willamette Valley, including Portland. For nearly forty years Southwestern Oregon has been without personal representation on the Supreme Bench. Justice Charles A. Johns was nominated and appointed to the Supreme Bench last May as Portland's representative. Will Portland now insist on still another and deny the southern half of Western Oregon any personal representation? All of the candidates, except Judge John S. Coke, are either from the immediate vicinity of Portland or the extreme northern line of the state, one being from The Dalles (a section already represented by Judge Bean, of Pendleton), and of the other two candidates, one is from Portland and the other one from Oregon City—only eight miles south of Portland.

Judge Coke's friends feel that Portland and Northern Oregon ought now to give him their support, since Justice Johns was chosen last May as Portland's representative. The additional vacancy, in fairness, ought to be given Southwestern Oregon. Judge Coke has exceptionally strong support in the six counties constituting his judicial district in Southwestern Oregon. There the people know him and have repeatedly expressed their approval of him. His record of nearly ten years as Circuit Judge is one of the highest in the State. Why not select for the important office of Justice of the Supreme Court a man of wide experience and known judicial qualifications? Why not select at least one of the seven Supreme Justices from the southern half of Western Oregon? Why not be fair? Why not regain from San Francisco the trade and business of one of the richest sections of Oregon by doing something more than merely making unfulfilled promises? Can Portland reasonably expect Southwestern Oregon's trade while denying it representation? Southwestern Oregon refuses to believe Portland is selfish. Southwestern Oregon awaits Portland's answer. We therefore ask those who believe in fairness to write Judge Coke's name and make the "X" in the ballot thus:



Why C. U. Gantenbein Should Not Be Elected Circuit Judge

In the present war the United States has had to equip and send two million troops to France. To accomplish this gigantic task it was in great need of trained military men. Judge Gantenbein was Oregon's foremost military man. Judge Gantenbein, while he was holding the office of Judge, and before he resigned, went to the training camp at the Presidio and spent three months training to be a soldier, and during that time he drew his salary as Judge, amounting to about \$1000, during which time he did not sit upon the bench or perform any services for Multnomah County or the state as Judge.
