

British Plan for Recognition of Bolsheviki Decried.

PICHON ISSUES STATEMENT

Government Will Make No Contract With Crime, Foreign Minister Declares Emphatically.

PARIS, Jan. 11 .- The British govern ment recently submitted to France a proposition involving an effort to obtain a truce in Russia which if successful would have led to the admission of delegates of the Russian Soviet government to the peace conference, according to a statment made today by Stephen Pichon, the French Foreign Minister.

The Foreign Minister declares in his statement the opposition of the French government to any plan which would give the present Bolshevik regime in Russia any recognition whatever. The 'criminal regime of the Bolsheviki," he insists, does not entitle them to recognition as a regular government and France is resolved to continue treating the Soviet organization as an enemy. The statement, which is over the sig-nature of the Foreign Minister, reads as follows:

British Plans Outlined.

"On January 5, 1919, the British Em-basay sent me a British proposition, which also was sent to Rome, Wash-ington and Tokio, suggesting the sending of a message to the government of the Soviets at Moscow, to the govern-ments of General Kolchak at Omsk, General Denikine at Ekaterinodar, and Nicholas Tschaikowsky at Archangel, and also to all the other governments constituted by the different Russian nationalities.



by themselves. "It may be added that aside from the Bolsheviki the allies can perfectly well admit the different Russian nationalities to present their claims. As regards the dangers with which the menace of the red armies threaten them, we should not cease to supply arms and money, and even military support, compatible with our aims.

'Method and patience combined, together with the impossibility that any regime can last without a regular organization for maintaining provision-ing, transport, order, credit, etc., will in the end overcome Russian internal anarchy. It may be prolonged for a certain time, but it can in no case pos-sibly triumph definitely, and we shall continue resolutely to refuse it any recognition and to treat it as an enemy. "S. PICHON."

PARIS, Jan. 11.-The American dele-gates to the peace conference dis-claimed today any knowledge of any such proposition from Great Britain regarding Russia as that to which Foreign Minister Pichon has replied. 
