

OREGON DENTISTS TO HOLD ANNUAL SESSION

Eastern Experts to Speak at State Convention.

TOMORROW OPENING DAY

Discussion to Center on Repair of Decayed Teeth—Large Attendance Is Forecast.

Dentists of the state will gather in Portland this week for the 24th annual meeting of the Oregon State Dental association. The session will open Monday and continue until Thursday evening. The morning and afternoon meetings will be held at North Pacific college and the evening sessions at the Portland Hotel auditorium. The programme this year promises to be of unusual interest to members of the dental profession, it has been announced, and a large number are expected to attend from all points of the state.

The principal speakers and clinicians at the sessions this year will be Dr. E. F. Roach of Chicago, authority on bridge work; Dr. P. Leland LeGros of Detroit, specialist in porcelain work; Dr. J. H. Hilderbach, child specialist of Portland, and Major R. L. Benson, Portland bacteriologist and pathologist, recently returned from army service abroad.

Repair of Teeth to Be Topic.

Special arrangements are being made this year for the women visitors and out-of-town dentists have been urged to bring their families. A committee composed of wives of Portland dentists has been named to have charge of this feature, as follows: Mrs. C. Adams, chairman; Mrs. J. C. Jones, Mrs. C. H. Moore, Mrs. A. F. Weeks and Mrs. H. C. Florent. All visiting dentists are being asked to register at the North Pacific college with the men.

The general entertainment committee is composed of F. H. Walgren, George H. Wainwright, Leon L. DeBois and N. L. Zimmerman.

The slogan of the dentists now is "100 per cent vital," and considerable time of the session will be taken up in discussing repair of badly decayed teeth without devitalizing. Dentists have come to consider that dead teeth are a menace to health, and some are holding that any tooth which has the nerve removed will in time bring serious consequences.

Association 42 Years Old.

The dental association is now 42 years old and has had 25 annual sessions. Invitations and announcements have been sent out this year to practically all dentists in the state, and those in charge believe that the attendance will not be a record.
