Valley Senators Supporting. To strengthen his line-up, Senator Ritner is said to have secured promise of support from several senators in the Willamette valley...

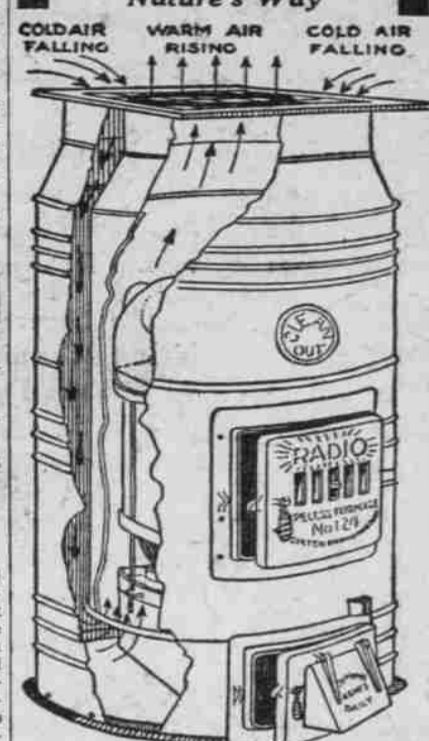
