ADMIRAL WILLIAM S. SIMS, recently brought conspicuously into the light of publicity by declining to accept a distinguished service medal, is the father of a 6-year-old lad who bears the name of the admiral, with Junior affixed. The little lad proudly wears a uniform and salutes with the snap of a veteran.

General Gaida, who recently led the uprising in Vladivostok against the Kolchak government, is a Czechoslovak. He formerly served in the Russian army.

Mrs. John A. Drake, an American woman, who did valiant service for Italian mothers and their babies both during the war and since the end of hostilities, has returned to New York. She was decorated for service by the president of the Italian Red Cross, the mayor of Rome, Gabriele D'Annunzio at Fiume, and was granted an interview by the pope that occupied 25 minutes.

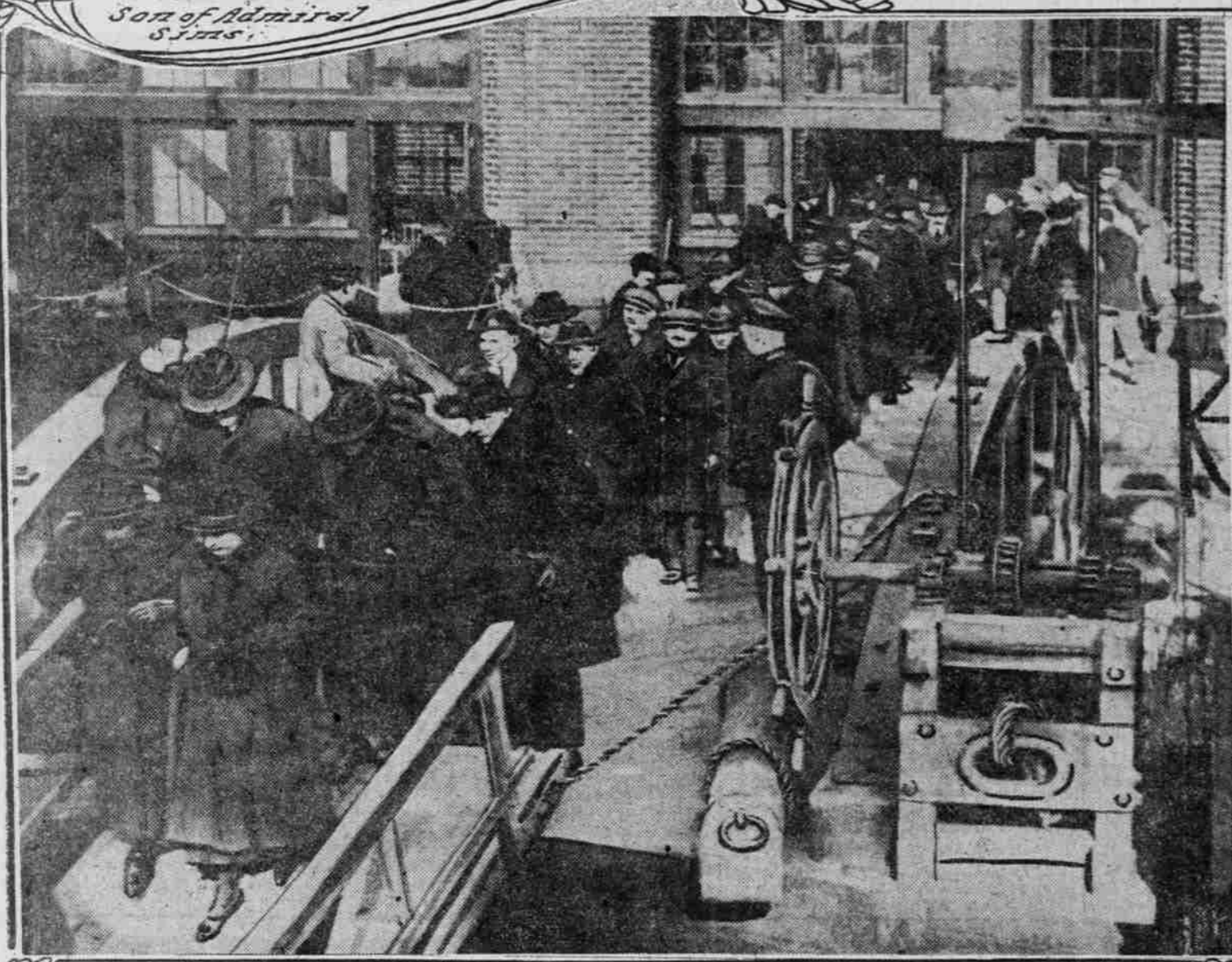

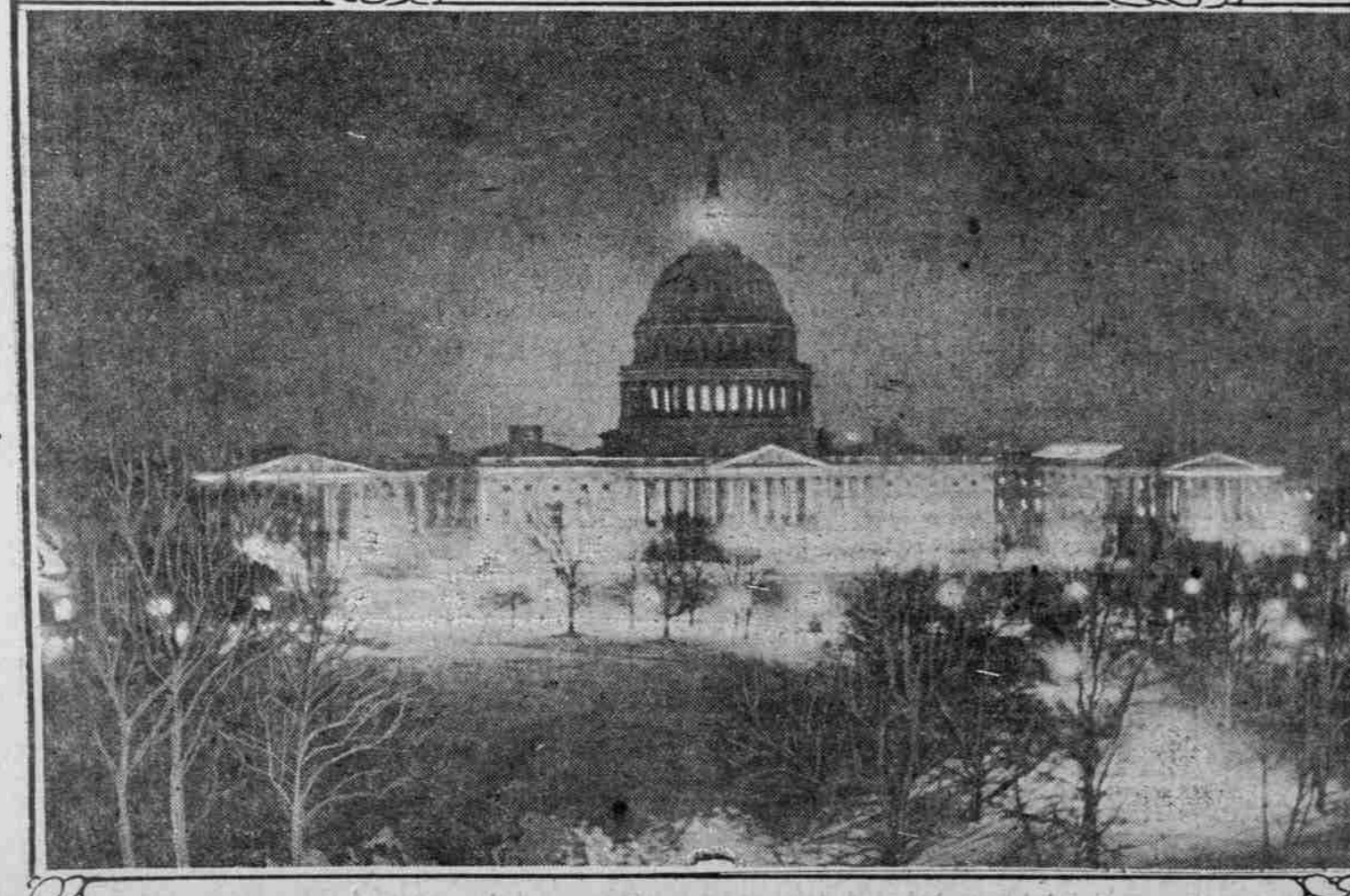

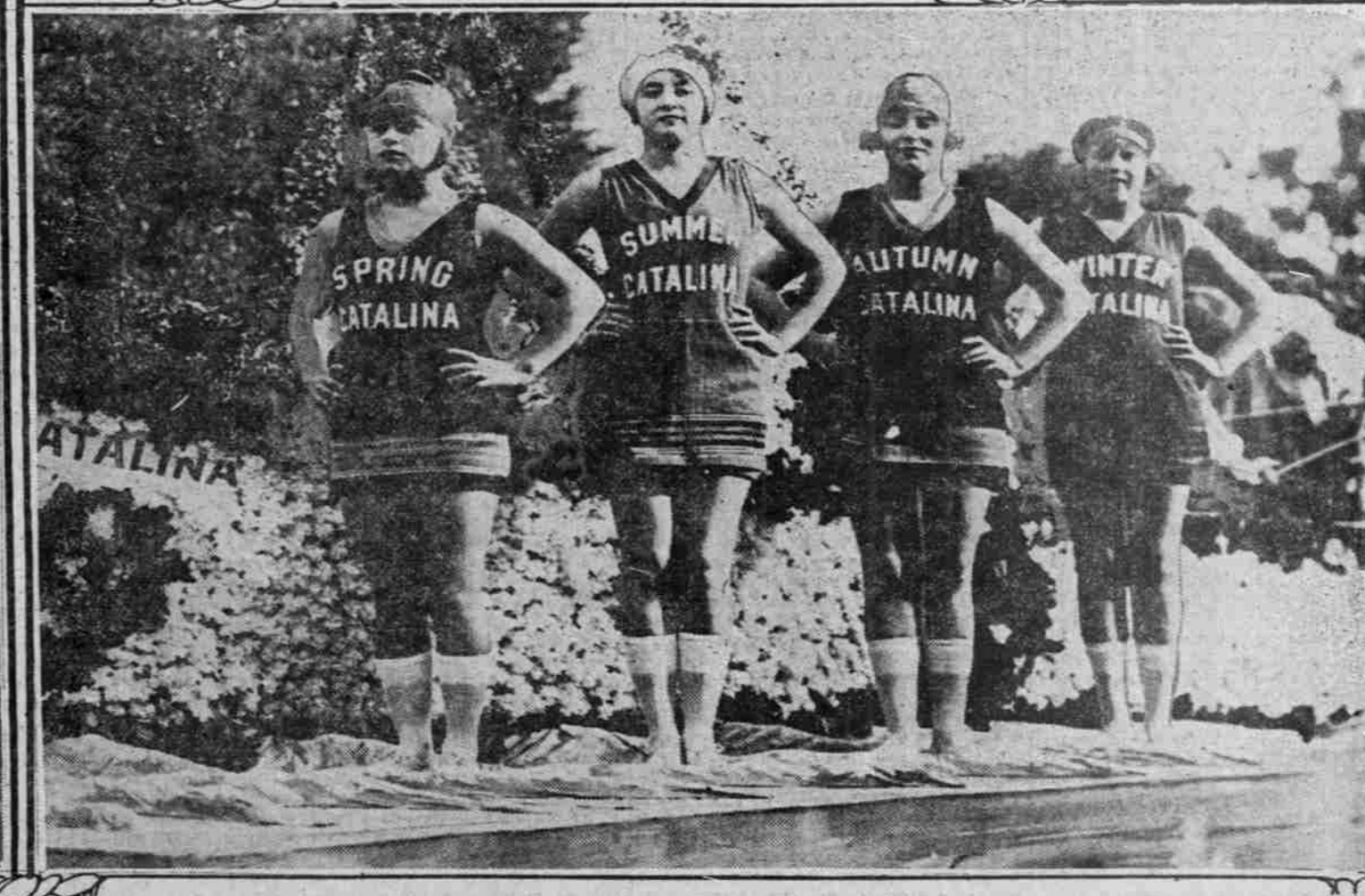
