### WASHINGTON, April 24.—

The United States has become a robber's roost, Senator Capper, republican, Kansas, declared in a prepared address today in the senate in which he scored profiteering and declared that if the law enforcement officers of the government could not enforce the laws they should resign "and let the men who can take their places."

### WASHINGTON, April 24.—

The United States may live in nine-billion style on a six-billion income. "Wall street's millionaires," he declared, "continue to be warmed by the sun of privilege, fertilized by the perspiration of labor and watered by the tears of savings stamps that will raise a record-breaking crop free from the blight of income taxes while the people are being urged to buy their coal early, to abstain from steak one day a week, and to purchase war savings stamps that the United States may live in nine-billion style on a six-billion income."

#### Chicago Packers Complete Sale of \$15,000,000 of Provisions.

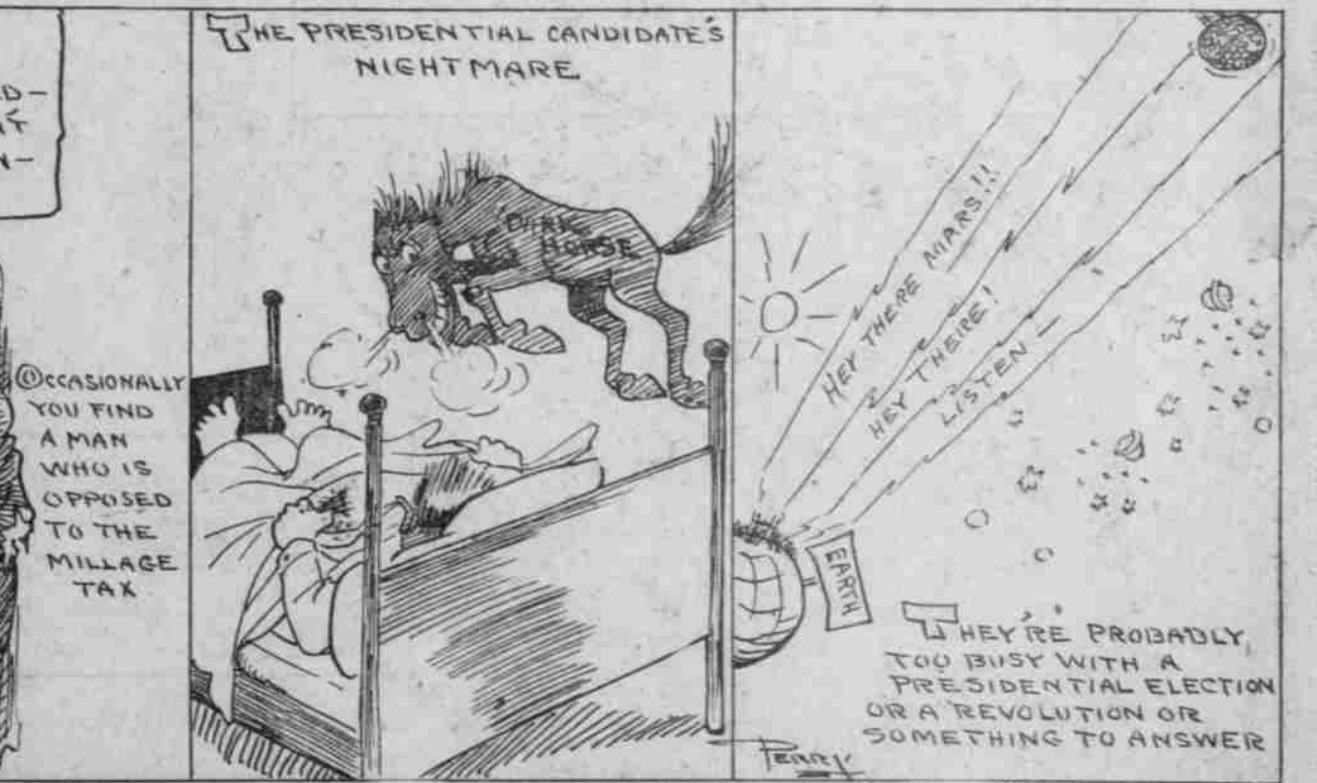
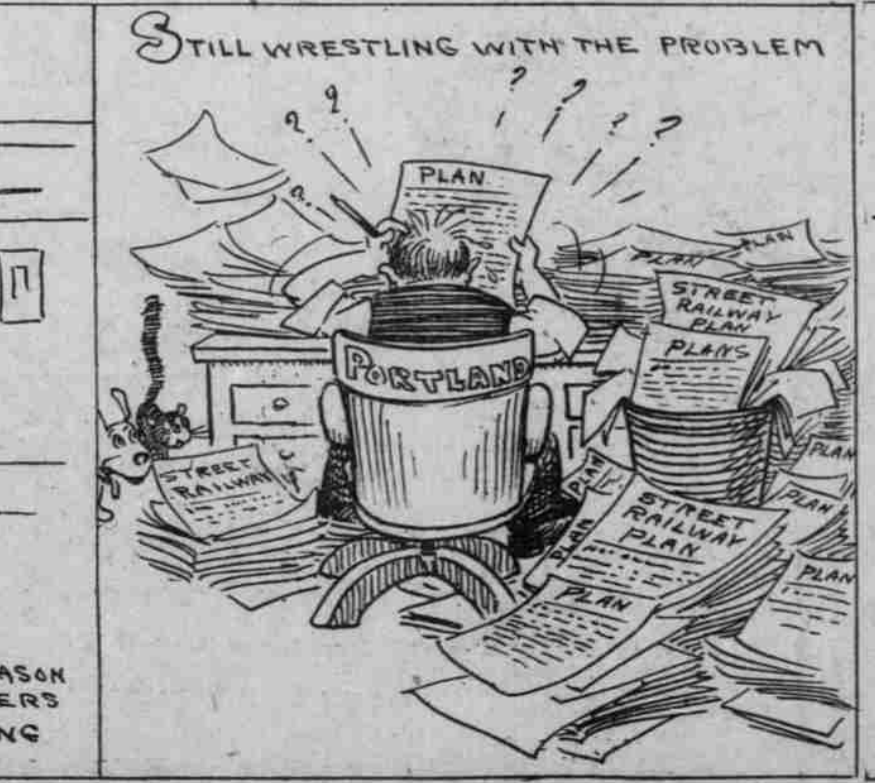
### CHICAGO, April 24.—
