

ANGLO-SAXON ALLIANCE IS A GOOD ONE BY LOCAL CLERGYMAN

Rev. R. H. Sawyer Tells of First Annual Congress of British-Israel World Federation.

THE outstanding feature of the first annual congress of the British-Israel World Federation, recently held in London, was the expression of the desire for a closer friendship and more intelligent working alliance between the two great Anglo-Saxon peoples, the United States and Great Britain.

The cordial welcome accorded by the people of England to their guests from America showed that England is not only ready to enter for such an alliance, because she realizes the necessity and because of her love for the people of her own race.

The objects of the federation are to promote the belief that the people of British or Saxon race within the British Isles and their offspring beyond the seas, including the United States of America, are of the stock of Israel.
