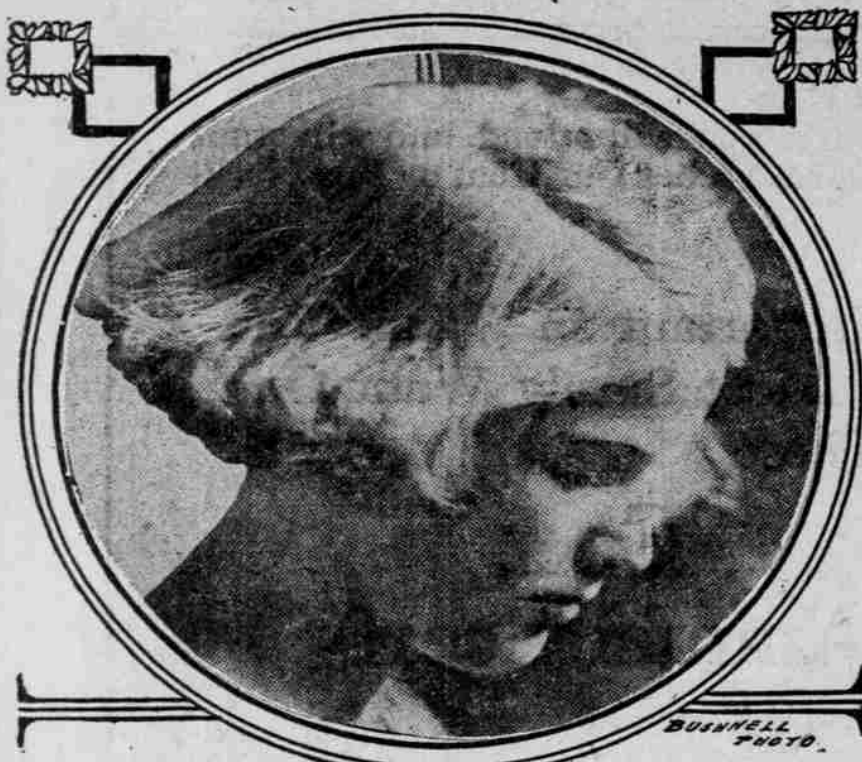

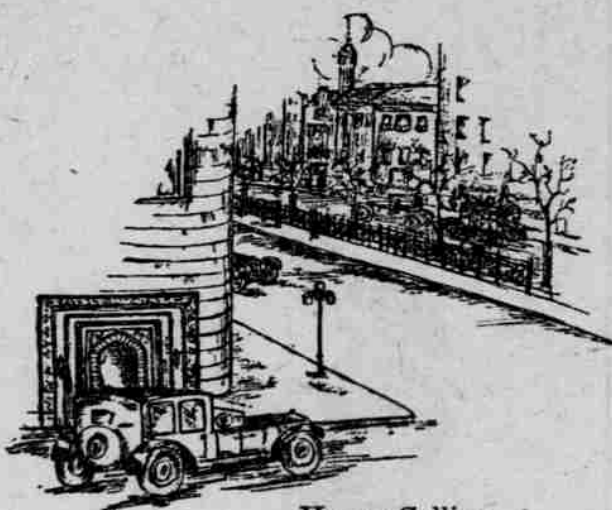

Mrs. A. L. Block returned on Tuesday after a month's absence in Salt Lake City and San Francisco.

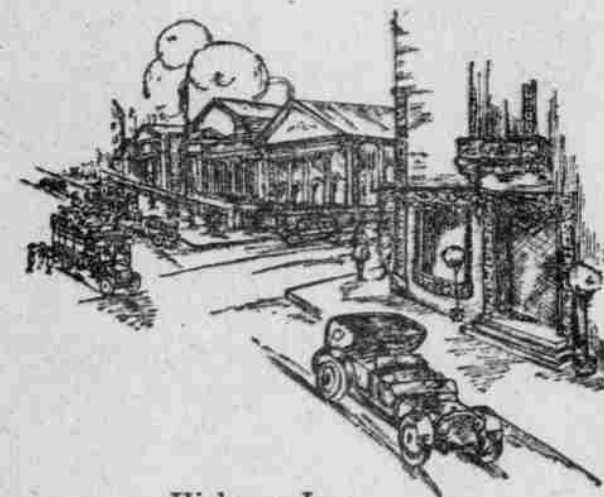
