
ARCHITECTS SHOULD BE CONSULTED BEFORE MAKING CHANGES IN HOUSE BEING BUILT

Strictly speaking, a pre-emptive bid should be a bid of three or more. There are many who still cling to the idea that an initial bid of two is a pre-emptive bid. Save in the case of a "two no-trump bid." which has been explained and which could only be overcalled by a bid of three, an initial bid of two is made more for the purpose of information than with the intent to have it serve as a pre-emptive bid. Undoubtedly, however, it at times accomplishes this purpose.




